Auctioneers Comments:
 Another very tight entry of 158 prime cattle met a similar trade, although there was some reluctance amongst buyers. Generally just a touch easier but the tight supply is holding the trade up. Store cattle are selling well and also with few strong stores available. Consequently finishers are under no pressure to sell, as replacements are hard to come by. Provided supply remains tight nationally, trade should hold.

Top was 209.5ppk (www.gth.net/gallery) for a very shapely, well fed, red Limousin steer from Mr AR Henson, who sold others similar at 205.5ppk, 203.5ppk and 197.5ppk twice. A run of well bred and well fed young cattle from Mr R & Mrs F Barrow & Sons sold well at 205.5ppk, 196.5 and 196ppk, all red Limousin steers 20m and a Black and White Blue steer (20m) at 195.5ppk. A very well fleshed, smart Limousin steer (16m) from Mr AGF Lockyer achieved 203ppk, when a 16m Charolais steer from the same farm sold well at 194.5ppk. A shapely leaner black Limousin from Mr RH Neale rose to 197.5ppk. Best steers generally around 200ppk. Better steers up and down of 190ppk. Good types around 180ppk. Commercial steers high 170's.

Steers sold to £1,457.55 for a Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at £1,419.54, £1,380.96, £1,365.49 and £1,327.20. Other Limousin steers over £1350 were from Mr RH Neale at £1,398.30; Mr RG Speed at £1,363.82 and Mr GI Ware at £1,353.75.

Heifers peaked at 204ppk for a smart Red Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold another at 194.5ppk. Well fleshed, shapely Limousin heifers from Mr CJ & Mrs JC Durston rose to 203.5ppk and 198ppk. Similar types from Messrs JS & M Frost at 198ppk and 197.5ppk.

Best heifers also around 200ppk. Better heifers high 180's. Good types mid to high 170's. Commercial heifers around 170ppk.

Heifers sold to £1,362.24 for a Limousin from Messrs CJ & JC Durston. Others over £1200 were Charolais heifers from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son at £1,307.55 and £1,269.65 and Mr JPT Scott at £1,233.84.

Overage to £1,248.20 for a Blue heifer from Messrs FL & NW Palmer, who sold another at £1,111.95 and a Blue steer at £1,229.28.

Others £95.20, £94.80 and £92.20 from Messrs TV & E Wotton; £93.20, £93 and £92.20 from Messrs CJ & JI Hayman and £92 from Messrs AJ Withers & Son. Overall average £88.27.
