**Auctioneers Comments:**

A very tight entry of 151 prime cattle and despite talk of falling deadweight prices, our liveweight trade "stood on" from last week's flyer, when this week's cattle looked dearer as generally last week's were of better quality. Supply is tight and that is the critical factor, which will determine whether the trade holds over the next month.

Top was 211ppk for a super butchers' type Limousin heifer from Messrs JS & M Frost, being a red Limousin, 525kg and exquisitely clipped for presentation at market ([www.gth.net/gallery](http://www.gth.net/gallery)). Other similar heifers from the same farm achieved 208ppk, 207ppk and 200.5ppk. A shapely cream Limousin heifer from Mr JPT Sott sold well at 210ppk. A shapely lean clipped Limousin from Messrs CJ & JC Durston achieved 208.5ppk. Other best type heifers over 200ppk at 205.5ppk, Limousin from Messrs RJ, HA & MR Popham; 202.5ppk, Limousin from Mr RH Neale and 202ppk, Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe. New Vendor, Mr SJ Webber made a good impression, when the best of his consignment of four well fleshed, smart Charolais heifers rose to 199.5ppk, with others at 196.5ppk and 195ppk. Better type heifers generally high 190's. Good heifers low 180's and commercial heifers low 170's.

Overage heifers sold well to 195.5ppk for a smart Limousin type from Messrs HWC & JM Butler, who sold another at 192ppk. 194.5ppk was also achieved by Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son with a better type Limousin.

Steers peaked at 208ppk for a very shapely, lean, red Limousin from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son, who also sold a lightweight Simmental at 196.5ppk. Messrs HWC & JM Butler scored with a shapely, clipped Limousin at 204.5ppk. Better type steers from Mr HJ Fisher rose to 200ppk for a Limousin and 194.5ppk for a South Devon. 198ppk was achieved by Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again with a better type Limousin. Better type steers high 180's and low to mid 190's, if capable for further feeding. Good type steers low to mid 180's. Commercial steers low to mid 170's.

Overage steers topped at 174.5ppk for an Angus from Messrs RL Vowles & Son.

Steers sold to £1,458.47 for a grand 863kg Charolais from Messrs RW & SJ Gay. Others over £1400 were a Charolais from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son at £1,432.60 and a grand 877kg Charolais from Mr A Toogood at £1,416.36.

Heifers topped at £1,351.08 for a quality Limousin from Messrs CJ & JC Durston. Others over £1,300 at £1,318.68 for a Blue from Messrs RL Vowles & Son and £1,302.26 for the Charolais from Mr JPT Scott.

Several cattle presented clipped for market from Messrs HWC & JM Butler, Messrs CJ & JC Durston, Messrs JS & M Frost, Mr HJ Fisher, Messrs RJ, HA & MR Popham and Messrs CHJ Atwell & Sons. One or two cattle forward being a little dirty and would have benefitted from being clipped.
