A reduced entry of 1194 Store Cattle (785) and stirks (409) on Easter weekend met a very brisk trade. The stores were dearer, as again cattle consigned were smaller as vendors begin to clear sheds. As many vendors finish their runs, numbers could rapidly dry up as we enter into May. Top of the day was £1225 for a top drawer 25m Charolais steer from Messrs RM Sparks & Son, Wellington. Others from the same farm £1105 (24m/25m). Other Charolais steers over £1100 came forward from Mr D Wright, Huntworth at £1180 (23m) and £1070 (22m); Mr D Wyatt & Son, Axminster at £1165 (24m) and Mr KD Browse, Sampford Peverell at £1115 (23m). Simmental steers also rose to £1100 for a smart 23m red and white from Mr CT Spiller, Hemyock. Other Simmental steers to £1055 (25m) from Messrs TL Spiller & Son, Cotleigh. Blue steers hit £1100 also (20m/21m) again from Messrs R & E Baker & Son, Cannington, with others from the same farm £1070. Other Blue steers sold to £1085 (22m/24m) from Messrs KD & MA Morgan, Wiveliscombe. Limousin steers peaked at £1095 for a shapely red (24m) from Messrs MJ Tarr & Son, Wellington. Others sold to £1025 for a strong bunch (19m/20m) from Messrs J Richards & Son, Chard.

Native steers rose to £1035 for smart red South Devons (22m) from Mr CT Spiller again, who sold others at £940. Hereford steers also over £1000 at £1005 (24m) from Mr RD Wilkins, Langport. Others £952 (22m) from Messrs F Manning & Son, Barnstaple; £910 (24m) Mr RD Wilkins again. Angus steers sold to £915 (25m) with sire details from Messrs KD & MA Morgan, Wiveliscombe. Others at £910 (25m) from Mr RD Wilkins again. Black and whites, still a strong trade to £858 for a well fleshed (23m) type from Messrs TA & AJ Reed, Honiton. Better type feeding Freisians at £695 (26m) Messrs I Keedwell & Son, Burrington; £690 (24m) Messrs MGC & SM Carter, Donyatt; £660 (26m) Mr K Proctor, Dunkeswell; £640 (16m) Messrs SE & RM Fry, Stewley. The heifers were also topped by Messrs RM Sparks, Wellington at £975 for a smart Charolais (23m). Fleshed Blue heifers (24m/26m) from Mr KD & MA Morgan again, rose to £910. Simmental heifers sold to £888 (25m) from Messrs TL Spiller & Son again. Others to £870 (20m) and fleshed from Messrs F Manning & Son again, who sold others at £825 (20m/22m). Strong Limousins (23m/26m) from Messrs HC Derryman & Son achieved £848. Other Blue heifers at £815 (21m) from Kent Agriculture Ltd, Yatton.

Native heifers rose to £835 for Herefords (24m) from Mr RD Wilkins again. South Devon heifers sold to £818 (25m) and fleshed from Messrs LG Bagg & Partners, Huntworth. Angus heifers peaked at £755 (20m/22m) from Messrs F Manning & Son again, who also sold Herefords at £752 (20m/22m).

Young stores in demand to £845 for a good Charolais steer (15m) from Messrs FG, NK & AJ Gammon, Tolland. £820 was bid for a 12m Hereford steer from Messrs A Male & Son, Kingsbury Episcopi. Good black Limousin steers (13m) from Messrs WA Rapson & Sons, Milton Abbot achieved £815. Another at £800 was a Simmental steer (14m) from Messrs WH & PJ Keirl, Middlezoy. Young heifers also close by at £798, for the best of a run of 12m/13m near pure Limousin heifers from Mr WJ Bown, who sold others at £785, £780, £740 and £710.

Our grateful thanks to all vendors on what was another cracking day for selling stores, after a sustained dry period and when the finished trade may have peaked for the moment.
