A very tight entry of 82 barren stock after Easter Monday met another very strong trade. A shortage of best suckler cows to hit the highs of former weeks and meat types a shade easier. Plain cows however as dear as ever.

Suckler cows peaked at 133.5ppk for a shapely red Limousin from Messrs ME & ML Bendle. Fleshed Blues to 128ppk from Messrs TV & E Wotton and 125.5ppk from Mr D Pengelly. Good and feeding sucklers 120ppk plus. Sucklers sold to £974.55 for the Limousin from Messrs ME & ML Bendle.

Black and whites fiercely contested to 132ppk for a smart fed type from Mr ES Triggol, who sold another at 126.5ppk. 127ppk was achieved by Messrs House & Son. Other better meat cows at 126ppk from both Finefarm Ltd and Messrs CS & JM Petheram. Finefarm Ltd sold another at 125.5ppk, as did Messrs Chedzoy & Gothard. Better cows 120ppk plus. Good meat 115ppk plus. Meat 110ppk plus. Steakers 105ppk plus. Very little below 100ppk and some of the plainest cows seen for some while achieved bids from 90ppk to 100ppk. Still a very strong trade.

Black and white cows sold to £1,066.41 from Messrs House & Son, who sold others at £990.60 and £900.06. Another over £1000 at £1,003.20 from Mr ES Triggol. Others at £965.93 and £958.65 from Messrs AW Hewlett & Son and £920.99 from Mr JC Gay.

Old stock bulls an excellent trade to 136.5ppk and £1,442.81 from Mr CC Hayman for a very smart red Limousin. 128ppk was also bid for a plain Blue from Messrs SR & L Hutchings.

Several clean overage forward, when black and white heifers achieved 127.5ppk from Mr H Carnell, who sold another at 121.5ppk when another from Messrs SR Curtis & Partners sold at 125ppk. Steers to 136ppk for a Simmental from Mr JC Gay.

More barren stock kindly requested to meet current buyer demand, at a time when many more than are being consigned could be sold to advantage.
