Auctioneers Comments:

A tighter entry than might have been expected ahead of a Bank Holiday market, reflecting a possible shortage of prime cattle generally, met a cracking trade, generally 5/6ppk up on the week. Best cattle at recent levels but middle order cattle displayed the most improvement. Best types rose to 163.5ppk for a very shapely, lean Blonde from Messrs G Dart & Son. A young black Limousin, packed with flesh, from Messrs MJ & C Plowright achieved 157.5ppk. Other better typed bullocks; 157ppk, red Limousin, Messrs EB & JA Webber; 156.5ppk, black Limousin, Messrs AFJ Redwood & Son; 156ppk twice, red Limousin, Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son and a Blonde, Messrs TV & E Wotton. Good steers generally high 140s with straighter sided cattle at or around 140ppk. Heifers generally a better show and an overall average of 147ppk is excellent. Best, top drawer types also to 163.5ppk for a very well fleshed Charolais from Messrs MJ & C Plowright again. A superb red Limousin from Messrs EB & JA Webber rose to 163ppk. A shapely Blue from Mr JA Selway Ltd achieved 161ppk, as did extremely well covered Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. A run of young, well fed Charolais from Mr S Broom sold well at 159, 158.5 and 158ppk. Other smart heifers at 158.5ppk, Limousin, Messrs GR Baker & Son; 158ppk, Limousin, Messrs JS & M Frost and 158ppk, the best of a good run of indoor continental heifers from Mr SER Hunt. Good heifers around 150ppk, when straighter sided types mid 140's. Some smart young bulls forward to 155ppk and £1168.70 for an extreme shape Blue from

Messrs R & B Boundy, who sold a good Hereford at £1116.58. Steers over £1100 again to £1146.33 for a grand Charolais from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, with a similar Charolais from Mrs EA Richards at £1143.90. Of note over £1000 were strong Holsteins from Messrs CE & BD Bailey at £1062.62 and £1042.50. Heifers also over £1000 at £1051.31 from Messrs MJ & C Plowright (Charolais); £1020.38, Messrs ARE & KA Sparks, (Charolais) and £1006.37, Mr GK Osborne (Simmental). Overage cattle also keenly sought to 142ppk for a Simmental heifer from Mr B Aplin, with a Blue heifer from Mr PJ Patch at 141.5ppk. Many thanks to all Vendors and Buyers alike for a most successful sale. With a deadweight equivalent of 277.5ppk can you afford not to get involved?
