Auctioneers Comments:

As ever fortune favours the brave. On the back of an easing trade, numbers have tightened and as a result trade lifted at least 10ppk. Some well presented cattle, with minimal waste, really sent the ring alight. Top was 164ppk twice, for a very shapely lean Limousin steer from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son and a very lean, smart Limousin heifer from Messrs V Young & Sons. Other top drawer steers from Messrs Hepper at 161.0ppk, 160.5ppk, 160ppk, 159.5ppk, 159ppk and 158.5ppk. Other good lightweight heifers from Messrs V Young & Sons at 161.5ppk and 160ppk. 161.5ppk received by Mr GK Osborne for a shapely Limousin heifer.

Many cattle 160ppk plus, with good runs to 159.5ppk twice (steers) from Mr MT Westaway; 158.5ppk twice (heifers) from Messrs K & N Crang and 157ppk (heifers) Mr SER Hunt. All grades of cattle dearer when straighter sided types were mid 140's. Prices of note were 154.5ppk and 154ppk for Angus from Mr M Besley.

Steers sold to £1,095.84 for a Limousin from Mr RJ Smith, with many more over the £1000 mark. Heifers peaked at £998.07 for a Blonde from Mr RW Mitchell. Several £900 plus.

Overage clean keenly sought again to 146.5ppk for a Simmental heifer from Messrs CG & C Vigar, when a Limousin heifer from Mr AM Doble achieved 144.5ppk. Better overage generally 130ppk plus. Steers sold to £958.50 for a Hereford from Messrs RL Vowles & Son, when heifers rose to £905.37 for the Simmental from Messrs CG & C Vigar.

What a difference a week makes and as many stock farmers chase straw, supply has tightened boosting the trade back up to former levels. Those vendors able to support and be loyal to Sedgemoor were well rewarded and once again the liveweight system proves its worth, with a deadweight equivalent of 281.5ppk

Others at 187ppk from Mr DA Kidner; 183ppk, 177ppk and 174ppk from Mr AAJ Bown; 182ppk and 176ppk from Mr WS Stitch; 179ppk and 175ppk from Mr CHE Kidner; 175ppk from Messrs HJ & HB Case Ltd and Mr AR Nicholls and 174ppk from Mr WHG Warmington and Mr RJ Wall. Heavier lambs were easily £75 plus to top at £85 from Mr AR Nicholls. Others at £83 and £79.50(x2) from Mr RH Hill; £82.50 from Mr CHE Kidner; £80 and £76.80 from Mr GB Holloway; £79 from Messrs S & J Willis; £78 from Mr C Reasons and £76 from Mr SJ Stables (x2), Messrs FG, NK & AJ Gammon, Mr FW Holloway, Mr RJ Wall and Messrs JR & RH Williams. Overall average £68.59.
