#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

Fortune favours the brave. A very tight bank holiday entry met a very strong trade, when many more could have been sold to advantage. Heifers topped at 166.5ppk for a lightweight Limousin from Mr RR Cheriton, who also sold another similar at 162ppk and a heavier heifer at 160ppk. Well fleshed Blue heifers from Mr SER Hunt achieved 163.5ppk twice. A lean shapely Limousin cross Devon from Messrs W Moore & Sons sold well at 162ppk. Another over 160ppk at 161.5ppk was a strong Charolais from Messrs JR & EA Roberts. Better heifers generally 150ppk plus. Steers also well sought after to 157.5ppk for a Simmental from Messrs Ruby Ventures Ltd, who sold another at 157ppk. The top steer price of 157.5ppk was also achieved by Messrs A & DM Dennis & Son with a lightweight Blue. A smart well fleshed Limousin from Messrs G Palfrey & Son rose to 157ppk, as did the best from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son, who sold another at 155.5ppk. Better steers also 150ppk plus but maybe not the quality forward on the steer front to keep up with the heifers. Steers sold to £1134.42 for a strong 777kg Charolais from Mrs EA Richards. Others over £1100.14 (Charolais) from Mr BA Sweet and £1110.42 (Blue) from Mr PJ Patch. Better steers all well over £1000. Heifers also over £1000 at £1090.13 for a Charolais from Messrs JR & EA Roberts. Others over £900 at £954.84 (Blue) from Mr SER Hunt and £914.55 for a smart Limousin from Messrs DH & SM Churchill. Overage steers rose to £1007.40 for a Hereford from Mr L Amesbury and overage heifers peaked at £791.52 for a Blue from Mr PJ Patch.

Trade is in the lift at present with second quality by far the most improved. More cattle are kindly requested to meet current demand and please book your entries in, even if its only one, as we have other buyers looking and we need to know number to secure them. Everyone counts.
