Auctioneers Comments:

Another tight entry and another very strong trade, on a par, if not dearer than last week's flier. When deadweight quotes languish around 247/250 (+5?) even after a slight rise, the trade through market is pounds dearer. When the deadweight equivalent returned at 278.5ppk, over £100 up on 350kg, how can anyone afford to give their cattle away at home. Come to market for best prices!

Some quality cattle on offer rose to 166.5ppk for a very shapely, lean Blonde heifer from Messrs KR & HE Harvey, who sold others at 159.5ppk, 155.5ppk and 151.5ppk. Steers peaked at 164.5ppk, for the best of a superb run of shapely lean Limousins from Mr D Fishleigh, who sold others at 159.5ppk, 159ppk (x2) and 158ppk. 160ppk was achieved by Mr RR Cheriton with a shapely well fleshed Limousin. From Mr D Boyland scored with a good, well fleshed Angus at 159.5ppk, as did Mr RH Neale with a good, well fleshed red Limousin heifer, who also sold another at 158ppk. Other smart Angus steers at 159ppk and 153.5ppk from Messrs EB & JA Webber. 159ppk was also bid for a better type red Limousin heifer from Mr M Potter. The best from Messrs TV & E Wotton, being a good well fleshed Charolais heifer rose to 156.5ppk, with another from the same farm, steer this time at 154.5ppk. A good lean Blue heifer from Mr PJ Patch sold well at 156ppk. Other good and better type cattle 150ppk plus.

Steers rose to over £1100 to £1108.80 for a Blonde from Messrs KR & HE Harvey, who sold others at £1098.90, £1068.33, £1061.78 and £1057.90. A strong Limousin from Messrs DH & SM Churchill achieved £1096.20. Others over £1050 at £1065.50 for a Limousin from Mr RJ Smith and £1058.40 for a red Limousin from Messrs CWM & GN Bolt. Many other steers £1000 plus. Heifers also over £1000 to £1002.83 from Messrs CWM & GN Bolt for a Blonde. Very well fleshed Gelbvieh from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son at £987.28. Others over £950 at £962.51 for a very strong Charolais from Messrs DH & SM Churchill and £960.96 for a Blue from Mr PJ Patch. More £900 plus.

Overage clean as keenly sought as ever, when some well fleshed cattle were on offer to 141.5ppk (x3) for a Limousin steer and heifer and Angus heifer from Mr CRG Wall. Steers sold to £1053.17 for a grand Simmental from Messrs ARE & KA Sparks. Heifers sold to £907.02 for the Limousin heifer from Mr CRG Wall.
