Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a massive Bank Holiday weekend entry saw a packed ringside. We lacked real quality with no real outstanding heifers on offer. The trade was selective but with new buyers from Kingsbridge and Shropshire, buying 25 between them everything sold at a fair price. Top price was £1860 for a non pedigree heifer from Mr AA Witcombe. Pedigree heifers to £1840 Messrs PC Pocock & Son and £1800 Mr J Snook. Cows to £1830 Mr MJ Potter, Gloucestershire and £1570 Mr NC Taylor. The largest entry of Jerseys ever on a Saturday sale created a lot of interest and sold to £960 and £940 for 2 incalf heifers from Mr R Mann. Calved Jerseys to £780 and £730 for M Potter, Gloucestershire. A grand consignment of 20m-22m Holstein bulling heifers met an exceptional trade to £930 to average £903 for Woodbridge Farms of Sturminster Newton. Calves to £200 Mr RJ Peach.

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report what numbers and what a trade! Near 1000 stores met a full ring of buyers and sold to a tremendous trade. One or two lesser types easier, which is inevitable with such great numbers, however generally trade was exceptional for this time of year, when well over 300 more cattle were sold against the same week last year. With a rising slaughter trade, there was a general enthusiasm amongst the buyers assembled.

Steers sold to £980 for a strong 26m Limousin from Mr BC Knapp, Pining, who sold a 26m Blue at £930. £960 was achieved by Messrs PT Bale & Son, Chard with a forward 26m Blue. Other steers over £900 at £940 for a grand 26m Limousin from Mr JT Norton, Sidmouth; £920, 21m Simmental from Mr MO Jones, Carmarthen; £910 and £900, 29m and 28m Limousins, Mr MJ Toogood, Wellington and £900 again for a 24m farm assured Limousin from Messrs SR & WR Ball, Wotton Under Edge. Better steers generally high £800's. Angus steers from Palace Farms Ltd, farm assured and with pedigree sire details at 22m/26m topped the special monthly Angus sale at £875. Other Angus, 24m at £800 from Messrs NT & AE Gear, Barnstaple. Herefords peaked at £820 (21m) from Messrs S Burnett, Langport. Others £795 (17m) Greenlane Farm. Messrs HC Derryman & Son, Honiton, topped the black and white steers for the second week running at £742, (FA and 25m) with another at £720 (overage) from Mr MF & MV Attwell. Some well fleshed heifers forward to £855 for a smart Simmental (27m) from Messrs PT Bale & Son again. £845 was achieved by both Mr FW Brown, South Molton with a 27m FA Charolais and Messrs W & EA Tratt, Luppitt, with a smart 20m FA Limousin. Others at or over £800 at £820, being a Charolais (22m) from Messrs E Gay & Son, Musbury and £800 for Charolais (25m) from Messrs AR & J Willmington, Misterton. Better heifers generally £750 plus, including 27m/28m Angus with pedigree sires from Messrs AR & J Willmington again.

Young stores rose to £835 for a quality 15m Simmental steer from Greenlane Farm, who also sold a 15m and 12m Charolais at £790 and £775 and a 15m Limousin at £750. £780 was bid for smart 14m/15m Charolais steers from Mr EJ Browse, Tiverton, who sold others 13m/14m at £735 and 12m/15m and 13/15m Charolais heifers at £660 and £655 respectively. £780 was also bid for a Simmental bull (14m) from Mr MO Jones, Carmarthen. Others £760 for shapely white Charolais (15m) from Messrs MP & DM Hine, Northay, who sold similar 15m heifers at £630. Another shapely consignment from Messrs KC & JC Heard, Okehampton rose to £720 for 15m/16m Blue and Blonde heifers, with other 12m/14m Charolais at £685 and 15/16m Blondes at £662 from the same farm.

All in all, quality and flesh improved. Some stale, plain types less. Many thanks to all Vendors, Purchasers and Staff alike for a most successful day.

### (307) Beef Breeds

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report an excellent entry though a steadier trade with most prices down around 10%, although a good demand for older calves. Most top continental bulls in the £240-£280 range. Only a few over £300 to top at £382 Messrs TS Jeanes & Partners (3 months). Young Blues £348 Messrs EG & CS Rowe & Son, others £334 ad £310. Charolais to £300 Messrs CG, GR & MS Spiller and £294 and £292 with strong Limousins from West Dibberford Farm to £292, others to £288 and £268. Medium bulls generally £200-£240, smaller bulls £130 upwards. Heifers more selective. Blues and Limousins generally easier though strong Simmentals £285 Mr J Marshall. Blues to £282 but most top heifers back on the £200-£230 range, with mediums £150-£200 and plainer sorts, particularly Limousins at around £120-150. Not quite the quality in the Angus and Herefords, not many over £200. Bulls, to a top of £220 for a Hereford from Brian Elworthy, while heifers reached £175, Messrs House. Angus just to £136 Mr FE Luff.
