A very tight entry as farmers busy themselves with hay, silage and straw. All classes very keenly sought to 128ppk for a top drawer Blue from Mr DM Ruell, who sold a well fleshed Charolais at 105ppk and a Simmental at 103.5ppk. A smart red Limousin from Messrs LJ Waygood & Son achieved 109.5ppk, as did another similar from Messrs AW Maidment & Partners, who also sold another at 105ppk. A well fleshed Hereford from Messrs SN & CA Perrin achieved 105ppk. Better feeding continental cows around the £1 mark. Sucklers sold to £985.60 for a tremendous 770kg Blue from Mr DM Ruell. Others to £819.06 and £798 for Limousins from Messrs AW Maidment & Partners. No best black and whites forward but a strong cow from Messrs FE Hill & Son achieved 98ppk, with another from the same farm at 94ppk. 95ppk was bid for another strong sort from Messrs BL Davies & Son. Meat cows around 90ppk, belly 85ppk. Plain cows to 80ppk which looked the dearest of all, including absolute skin and bones to 60ppk plus. Black and whites sold to £754.60 from Messrs FE Hill & Son. Another over £700 at £722 from Messrs BL Davies & Son. A grand Charolais bull from Mr DM Ruell achieved £1029.42. Although prices would not appear as high as recently, it was not the best show of cows seen at Sedgemoor and as such were just as dear, plain cows especially so. We strongly recommend Vendors sell in August, which last year saw the trade hold up ahead of the fall.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

**All cattle born on or after 15<sup>th</sup> April 1998 require two tags.**

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15<sup>th</sup> April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.
