Auctioneers Comments:

A tighter entry at 182 prime cattle and a dearer trade again. Against all expectations for August, the trade has hardened again and moved up as finished cattle continue to be scarce. Many Vendors selling forward on probably what is the best period for selling in living memory.

Top was 195ppk for a top drawer red Limousin heifer from Messrs PA Strawbridge. Steers peaked at 191ppk from Messrs R & J Dare for a suckler bred Limousin.

Best steers and heifers generally 180ppk plus. Better cattle mid to high 170's. Good types around 170ppk. Few straighter sided types on offer, in what was an excellent show of cattle, around the mid to high 160's.

Steers sold to £1,328.58 from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners, who sold another Blonde steer at £1,303.52. Many £1200 plus.

Heifers sold to £1,190.09 for a Blue from Messrs RW & SJ Gay, with another from the same farm at £1,131.90. Many £1000 plus.

Young bulls in demand to 176.5ppk for a black Limousin from Mr R Coate. Others to 176ppk for a Blonde from Messrs R & B Boundy.

Overage clean in keen demand to 177ppk for a Limousin heifer from Mr MW Edwards. Steers sold to £1,175.05 for a Limousin from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet.
