***Thank you to those Vendors who book in their stock which helps buyers plan haulage and organise kill slots.***

A typical Bank Holiday entry and trade to match, on a day when fortune favoured the brave. Trade again dearer as there seems to be no end to the rise in the value of beef cattle. Is this the top or will they go dearer again ahead of any Autumn flush, if indeed there is an Autumn flush to be had?

Top was 198.5ppk with another at 195.0ppk for two top drawer red Limousin heifers from Mrs M Forward. A black, shapely Limousin heifer from Messrs DH & SM Churchill also hit 191.5ppk. Steers sold to 187.0ppk for a R grade black Limousin steer from Messrs DB Hawkins & Son.

Steers sold to £1439.54 for a Charolais from Messrs FJ Webber & Son, who sold another at £1422.14. A smart Blonde steer from Mr AA Knight returned at £1362.19. Many £1100 plus.

Heifers over £1100 at £1196.96 and £1160.25 for Limousins from Mrs M Forward and £1130.31 and £1121.75 for Charolais from Messrs M & J Gibbins. Many £1000 plus.

Overage clean at £1358.18, £1234.02, £1187.50 and £1174.94 for Limousin, Simmental, Charolais and Hereford steers from Mr DJ Rosewell and £1160.56 for a Limousin steer from Mr MR Lee. Overage heifers to £1053.67 for a Limousin from Messrs A & SA Edwards.

Young bulls to £1100.13 for a lean, shapely Simmental from Mr RN Darch.

Prices of note were a strong run of Friesian steers, which sold to £1167.06 from Mr JA Selway Ltd.
