**Auctioneers Comments:**

A very tight entry of prime cattle at 155 met a tremendous trade. A shortage of farm assured cattle and many very lean types as Vendors sell forward on the rising trade. Quality generally well down on last week's yet the averages are very similar, reflecting the current strength of the trade.

Top was 199.5ppk for a very well fleshed, shapely and farm assured steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold another at 190ppk. 194.5ppk was achieved by Messrs PA Strawbridge with an exceptionally shapely and lean Limousin steer.

Heifers rose to 189.5ppk for a quality Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again. Others to 187.5ppk for a well fleshed Blue from Mr SER Hunt.

Best steers generally 180ppk plus. Heifers low 180's. Better steers and heifers high 170's. Good types mid 170's. Straight sided sorts high 160's.

Prices of note were 173.5ppk, 169.5ppk and 164ppk for young barley Friesian steers from Messrs Dyer & Co, who also sold a young Blue bull at 182.5ppk.

Overage cattle followed suit and were keenly sought to 168.0ppk twice for a Hereford steer from Mr DR House and an Angus heifer from Mr WS Hancock.

Steers sold to £1,300.55 for a lean Charolais from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners. Several £1200 plus.

Heifers sold to £1,224.91 for a strong Blonde from Messrs M & J Gibbins, with others £1100 plus.
