Auctioneers Comments:

Thank you to those Vendors who book in their stock which helps buyers plan haulage and organise kill slots.

A reduced entry of very mixed quality, as many Vendors begin to select from end of season grass cattle, having already sold the best. Yet what a time to be selling them. Never before have we seen an end of August trade quite like it currently is. Although the overall averages are back, when quality is taken into consideration, some second and third quality cattle sold exceptionally well.

Top was 192.5ppk twice for an extremely shapely and equally lean Charolais steer from Mr RJ Smith and a very shapely and well fleshed Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. Best cattle 180ppk plus at 185ppk for another very shapely and lean type, being a Blonde heifer this time from Messrs DH & SM Churchill; 183.5ppk for a quality Blue steer from Mr & Mrs GJ & PC Perry; 182.5ppk for another lean smart Blonde, this time a steer from Messrs AG Knight & Son; 182ppk for a plum Blonde heifer from Messrs JR & EA Roberts and 180.5ppk for another well fleshed Limousin steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. Better type cattle high 170's. Good sorts around 170ppk. Straighter sided cattle around the mid 160's for steers and 160's for heifers.

Young bulls to 170ppk for a lean good type Simmental from Messrs R & B Boundy.

Overage clean similarly keenly sought to 168.5ppk for a Limousin heifer from Messrs JR, LM & AJ Hutchings, with steers to 166ppk for a strong Blue from Messrs J & N Meaker & Son.

Steers sold to £1267.35 for a well finished Blue from Messrs M & TD Ellis. Several steers £1200 plus, including overage. Heifers peaked at £1188 for a 675kg well covered Charolais from Messrs M & J Gibbins. Best £1100 plus again including overage. Bulls to £1156 and £1111.66 for a Simmental and Saler respectively from Messrs R & B Boundy. Many thanks to all Vendors for their continued support. Remember, we want you to do better, as when you do well we also do well.
