A slightly smaller entry to last week's met another electric trade with quality at a premium. Steers averaged well over the £500 mark for the 2<sup>nd</sup> week running and heifers over £450! Top price was £850 for a 15m BB steer from Mr C George, who also made £750 of an 8m Limousin steer. The normal excellent entry from Taylors Farm saw prices to £825 for a Charolais steer 11m. Others to £685. A strong consignment of Angus from Miss LA Norman achieved £730 (6m) and £555 (6/7m) x5. Limousins to £685 (10m) from Messrs WNH & SA Cobden, who also made £680 10m x2, others to £665 (9/10m). Mr BD Elworthy topped the Herefords with a 10m steer to £665, others to £585 and £565. Simmental to £665 (12m) from Mr S Simmons, others to £605. A classy show of Blondes from Messrs PA & CE Edwards to £658 (10m), £632 x4 (9/10m) and heifers to £555 x5 (8/9m).

Heifers were up on the week, topped again by Taylors Farm at £655 (7/11m) for a pair of Charolais, others to £485. Devons to £640 from Mr S Simmons (16m) who also had a Blue to £610 (14m). Messrs WNH & SA Cobden's run of Limousin heifers topped at £605 x2 (10/13m) with South Devons to £595 x4. Other Limousins £590 x2 (12/13m). A quality entry of Angus made £470 x5 (6/7m) from Miss LA Norman. Very few Friesians on show met a brisk trade for what was on offer, £378 from Mr SE Davey, others to £325 and £290 x4.

Many more could have sold to advantage, come early and avoid the Autumn rush.

Not quite the numbers of last week at 207 beef calves, with a shortage of passports around this week but another exhilarating trade. Best suckler bred continental bulls to £450, £440, £432 and £415 Mr I Sevenoaks. Dairy bred Charolais to £368 and Simmentals £360 Mr MW Ford; £355 Messrs Harvey, with Blues to £350 Messrs AJ Bennett & Sons, Templecombe and Limousins £350 Messrs Padfield of Wiltshire. Best continental bulls £280 but mediums very sharp in the £230-£270 range and tremendous demand for small bulls to £200.

Heifers continue to rise with Blues to £328 Mr R Angell and £306 Mr D Croton. Plenty of heifers £220-£260 with buyers from far a wide. Mediums £160-£220, even small heifers to £150.

Outstanding bulls in the native section saw Angus bulls to £298 and Herefords £250, with heifers to £232 (exceptional) Messrs Masters for Angus and Hereford heifers to £221 Evercreech Park Farm and £205 Mr RD Knight. More calves needed to satisfy demand.
