Bring your cows to market for best prices! Out of no where, the trade has rocketed, with beef average shooting up 10ppk and the dairy average 6ppk. Livestock markets are the vehicle to expose this demand. Bring your cows to market. Top of the day was 144.5ppk for an exceptional Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber. Another good Blonde, this time from Messrs FG & LA Knott achieved 125.5ppk. A young Limousin from Mr NW Payne rose to 125.5ppk. Other older cows over 120ppk were a Limousin at 123.5ppk from Messrs Mitchell Bros; 122ppk for a Limousin from Messrs J & K Barnard Farms Ltd and a good Simmental from Mr ER Adams. Several better sucklers 110ppk plus. Sucklers sold to £1213.80 for the Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber. A tremendous 1042kg Charolais from Messrs W Hilborne & Son achieved £1104.52. Others over £1000 were the Blonde from Messrs FG & LA Knott at £1097.50 and the Limousin from Messrs Mitchell Bros at £1002.82. Other strong sucklers £900 plus. Black and whites sold to 116ppk for a young cow from Messrs R & J Jones & Son. Other young cows 108.5ppk, Messrs DW Rowe & Son; 106.5ppk Mr CA Heywood and 104.5ppk Messrs R Lucas & Son. Older cows peaked at 109.5ppk twice from both Messrs Quick & Sons and South Widcombe Dairy. Greenslade Taylor Hunt, Sedgemoor Auction Centre Livestock Pennage Security Policy

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence.

Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.

If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
