#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

Another good entry around the 200 mark met a trade, just a touch easier, yet still well ahead of other methods. Top of the sale was a near perfect Limousin cross heifer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold a good Limousin steer at 161.5ppk. Steers topped at 164.5ppk for a top drawer red Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at 164ppk and 161.5ppk and a South Devon at 157.5ppk. A very shapely, homebred Limousin cross from Messrs C Tripp & Son achieved 162ppk. The best of a smart run of Limousin steers from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son rose to 161.5ppk. Other well shaped and fleshed Charolais heifers from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners and Mr BA Richards achieved 159.5ppk and 157ppk respectively. Better cattle generally 150ppk plus. Good sorts 145ppk to 150ppk. Quite a wide spectrum of finish forward from very lean store grade 1, to really over fat 5H. Some lean cattle running out of time but attention needs to be given to draw cattle before they become too fat.

Steers sold to £1163.76 for a grand Simmental (746kg) from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem, who sold a Blonde (777kg) at £1153.85 and a Charolais at £1125.77. Another over £1100 was the Limousin from Messr C Tripp & Son at £1135.62. Better steers generally £1000 plus.

Heifers rose to £1065.72 for the Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. Others over £1000 from Mr A Lucas (Charolais) at £1026.33 and Messrs NJ & CA Payne (Simmental) at £1010.85. Better heifers generally £900 plus.

Overage clean as dear, if not dearer and as keenly sought as ever to 154ppk for a quality Blue heifer from Messrs J & A Moon. Overage steers topped at 149ppk for a Limousin from Mr ME Sparks. Overage steers also over £1100 to £1104.95 for a strong Simmental (770kg) from Mr HJ Fisher. Others £1099.80 (Blue) Messrs SW Batten & Sons; £1074.85 (Charolais) Mr HJ Fisher again and £1071.34 (Charolais) Mr D Purchase. Heifers also over £1000 at £1021.62 for a Charolais from Mr BA Richards. Others over £900 from Messrs J & A Moon (Blue) at £988.68 and Mr D Purchase (Charolais) at £921.60.

Cattle clipped for market from Messrs J & A Moon, Mr MC Bailey, Messrs JC & TG Merchant, Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners, Messrs CJ & J Lang, Messrs R & S Dare, Messrs W Johnson & Son, Mr BA Richards, Messrs GW & GM Long & Son, Messrs LG Bagg & Partners, Messrs NM & CL Norris and Messrs CHJ Atwell & Son, with the best turned out honour being taken by Messrs NM & CL Norris.
