Auctioneers Comments:

A much larger entry, the first time over 300 for some while, which was a wonderful show for which Vendors must be congratulated and will hopefully put Sedgemoor in the top five and cement it's national significance. Trade still very firm up to 174ppk for a superb black Limousin cross heifer from Mr GJP Cleave. Other best Limousin cross heifers from Mr GJP Cleave at 172ppk (twice) and 160.5ppk and Mr A Cleave at 169ppk and 158ppk. Other shapely heifers at 163ppk (Limousin cross) Mr MJ Chilcott; 159.5ppk (Blonde cross) and 159ppk (British Blue cross) Messrs DM Jones & Partners; 159.5ppk (Limousin cross) Mr TJ Thomas; 159ppk (British Blue) Messrs P Fewings & Son, with many well fleshed heifers 155ppk to 158ppk.

Steers peaked at 171ppk for a top quality Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold others at 167ppk and 161.5ppk. 170.5ppk was achieved by Messrs RJ, HA & MR Popham with a best Limousin. Top drawer Blonde from Mr MJ Chilcott hit 167.5ppk. 167.5ppk was also received by Mr J Wakely with a smart Limousin. Well fleshed Limousin crosses from Messrs HWC & JM Butler met calls of 166.5ppk and 157.5ppk. A run of well fleshed Blues from Messrs FE Hill & Son rose to 162ppk. A smart heavyweight (785kg) Limousin from Messrs P & R Fishleigh rose to 160.5ppk. Mr GJP Cleave scored again with a Limousin steer at 159.5ppk. The best of a good run from Messrs DJ & MC Few rose to 159ppk. 159ppk was also achieved

by Messrs G Palfrey & Son with a shapely Limousin. Many good steers 155ppk to 158ppk.

Steers sold to £1259.93 for a grand 785kg Limousin from Messrs P & R Fishleigh. Another over £1200 at £1209 was a tremendous 806kg Limousin from Mr GJP Cleave. **15 steers over £1100 and 52 over £1000.**

Heifers topped at £1051.90 for a strong 670kg Charolais from Messrs Winslade & Son. Another 700kg from Messrs JR & EA Roberts achieved £1046.50. Other stronger heifers over £1000 at £1043.80 (Charolais) Mr RE Webber; £1031.36 (Blonde) Mr SER Hunt; £1019.10 and £1011.98 (Charolais) from Mr FW Holloway. **33 heifers over £900.**

OTM clean again keenly sought to £1036.58 for a Limousin steer from Messrs RM Sparks & Son. Another £1014.38, Mr NW Doble. Heifers sold to £965.03 for a smart Blonde from Mr DJ Prouse. Charolais to £919.66, Messrs HWC & JM Butler.

A tremendous market and yet again we welcome former deadweight Vendors back to the market. Many, thankfully released from the straightjacket of bTB and others taking advantage of the leading liveweight trade. Markets are here to help all farmers with no contracts, no grading, just full market value and quick payment.
