#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a tight entry met a similar trade for the best but the middle order were at least 5ppk dearer. Some of the third grade cattle looked very dear indeed. On a back drop of falling deadweight quotes, the trade bucked the trend. To put it into context, some of the middle order cattle, which would not kill out well, were close to 300ppk deadweight.

Top of the day was 171.5ppk for the best of a superb run of well fed Limousin steers from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at 168ppk, 167.5ppk, 165.5ppk and 164ppk. 169.5ppk was bid for a Blue show steer from Mrs MJ Quantick, who sold a Limousin show steer at 168ppk. Very smart home bred Limousin steers from Messrs CJ & JC Durston achieved 168ppk, 164.5ppk and 164ppk. A Blue show steer from Mr AW Barrow rose to 163ppk. Better shape steers around 160ppk. Good steers 150ppk plus. Straight sided 140ppk to 145ppk.

Steers sold to £1,189.89 for the Blue show bullock from Mrs MJ Quantick, whose Limousin achieved £1,137.36. Several steers over £1,100, including Limousins from Mr AR Henson at £1,177.68, £1,133.73, £1,109.61 and £1,105.00. Strong Limousins from Mr RH Neale achieved £1,136.68, £1,132.50 and £1,126.13 and the best from Messrs CJ & JC Durston sold to £1,110.48.

Heifers peaked at 167ppk for a very shapely Blue from Messrs FA Hudson & Son. Very well fed heifers from Mr MJ Chilcott sold well at 164.5ppk, 164ppk and 158.5ppk (twice). The best of a run from Messrs KR & HE Harvey rose to 162.5ppk. Better heifers mid 150's. Good heifers close to 150ppk. Straight sided types 140ppk plus. Heifers also over £1,100 at £1,143 for a tremendous 791kg Charolais from Messrs L & FJA Christopher. Others over £1,000 from Messrs RG & A Pearce at £1,027.84 (Charolais) and Messrs J & A Moon at £1,026.63 (Blue). Many £900 plus. Overage clean also keenly sought to £1,076.40 for a Limousin steer from Messrs GDW Isaac & Son.

Many buyers were unable to satisfy their requirements and we request more cattle to satisfy current demand.
