A tight entry met a yet further improved trade. After last week's trade of the year, prices rose again when black and whites averaged 95.5ppk and sucklers sold to £1,196.82. Sucklers peaked at 127ppk for a smart Red Limousin from Messrs CF & WE Richens. Other better sucklers 120ppk plus at 123ppk and 120ppk, Charolais from Messrs AP Parris & Son; 122ppk, Charolais, Mr J Wylde; 121.5ppk, Limousin, Messrs HWC & JM Butler and 120ppk again, Charolais, Messrs O & K Cook. Good cows 110ppk to 115ppk. Sucklers sold to £1,196.82 for a tremendous 981kg Charolais from Mr J Wylde.

Another over £1100 was a Limousin from Messrs HWC & JM Butler at £1,129.95. £1,011.29 was achieved by Messrs J & NP Cavill. Better cows £900 plus.

Black and whites at near unprecedented levels up to 113.5ppk for an older cow from Messrs J & NP Cavill. Other best cows 112ppk, Messrs JC Gay & Son; 111.5ppk, Cole Farming Ltd; 109.5ppk, Messrs MM & EH Lucas; 109ppk thrice for Mr WWD Blanch, Messrs J & NP Cavill again and Messrs RKM House & Son. Many better cows 105ppk to 107.5ppk. Good cows 100ppk plus. Half meat types 90ppk plus. Plainer steakers 80ppk plus. Hardly any below. Black and white heifers to 118.5ppk from Messrs AR Broom & Son, with another at 118ppk from Messrs RG Greenway & Son.

Black and whites sold to £949.37 from Messrs MM & EH Lucas. Another over £900 at £937.40 from Messrs RKM House & Son. Many cows £800 plus.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: to request permission.
