Come to market for best prices! A short entry of cows met a flying trade, best of the year to date. Many, many more could have been sold to advantage.

Top was 125ppk twice for a better type Blue from Mr RG Speed and a smart Blonde slip from Mr RJ Marks. Good meat sucklers at 115ppk, Limousin, Mrs AC Tucker; 114.5ppk and 111.5ppk Simmental and Blonde, Mr DW Parris and 113ppk Messrs HK & S Cligg. Meat sucklers 100ppk plus. Feeders up to 100ppk depending on how well fleshed.

Sucklers sold to £1,153.73 for an outstanding 1021kg Simmental from Messrs HK & S Cligg. £927.50 was received by Mr RG Speed for their Blue. Other good cows over £800 at £996.31 and £881.50, Simmentals from Messrs HK & S Cligg again; £861.04, Simmental, Mr DW Parris; £814.60, Blue, Mr MB Downing and £800.98, Simmental, Messrs JS & M Frost.

Black and whites fiercely contended to 113ppk for a heifer from Mr CV Salmon. Cows rose to 111.5ppk from Messrs M & TD Ellis. Other best meat cows 109.5ppk, Messrs RE Fewings & Son; 108.5ppk thrice, Mr RB Bowditch & Son, Messrs IJ & SA Bell & Son and Messrs Chedzoy & Gothard; 108ppk twice, Messrs M & TD Ellis again and Messrs RKM House & Son. Good meat black and whites 100ppk plus to 106ppk. Steakers 90ppk to 95ppk. Plain and belly 85ppk plus. Very few exceptionally plain cows in the 70's, which looked the dearest again sold.

Black and whites sold to £863.66 from Messrs Chedzoy & Gothard. Others over £800 at £859.66, £847.40 and £839.16 from Messrs M & TD Ellis; £858.99 Messrs RKM House & Son; £824.60 Messrs IJ & SA Bell; £813.59 Messrs RE Fewings & Son and £807.02 Messrs GW & GM Long & Son. Some well fleshed cows forward which pulled the scales and encouraged the bidders.

Old bulls to 107.5ppk and £1,122.30 for a Charolais from Mr J Wylde. Holstein Friesian to 95ppk and £950.95 from Messrs IJ & SA Bell & Son.

Overage clean to 122.5ppk for the best of a run of Friesian steers from Messrs Collier Bros & Son.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: to request permission.
