Top of the day was 129.5ppk for a top drawer Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber, who sold others at 127 and 123ppk. Other sucklers to 122ppk for a Blue from Messrs J & NP Cavill, 119.5ppk for a Charolais from Mr EJ Cope, 116.5ppk for a Blue from Mr C Grant-Ives, 115.5ppk for a Limousin from Mr R Chaddock, 114.5ppk for a Devon from Messrs EW Jeanes & Son and 113.5ppk for a Limousin from Messrs P & G Ford. Good sucklers 100ppk plus to 112ppk. Leaner types up to 100ppk. Sucklers sold to £1082.04 for a grand 852kg Blonde from Messrs GH & MG Barber, who sold others at £1013.99 and £905.28. Other good sucklers £884.52, Charolais from Mr RE Webber; £878.41, Blue from Mr C Grant-Ives; £872.58, Simmental from Messrs JS & M Frost and £865.28 for a Devon from Messrs Hopcraft Ltd. Black and whites very keenly sought to 119ppk for a heifer from Messrs Colgrove Partnership, Mevagissey. Older cows rose to 113ppk for a well fleshed clean type from Messrs PW & MA Bell. Other best meat cows at 110ppk, Messrs Cole Farming Ltd; 106.5 and 105ppk Messrs CE & BD Bailey and 105ppk twice from Messrs Bailey Bros. Better meat cows 100ppk plus, with plenty in this bracket. Good cows 90-95ppk. Meat cows with belly 85ppk. Plain cows 75 to 85ppk. Very plain cows 55 to 75ppk plus depending on how empty. Some of the plainer cows looked very well sold. Black and whites sold to £949.30 from Messrs Cole Farming Ltd. Another over £900 at £925.60 was a grand 890kg cow from Mr NW Doble. Cows sold over £800 for Messrs PW & MA Bell at £867.84; Messrs K Milverton & Son at £856.95; Messrs CE & BD Bailey at £855.75 and £800.80; Messrs Bailey Bros at £835.50; Mr P Saunders at £804.65 and for Messrs AE & WF Chinnock at £800.88. Many, many black and white cows £700 plus. Stock bulls rose to 111ppk and £988 for a younger (under 48m) bull and an old bull, both being Blondes from Messrs KR & HE Harvey. #### Livestock Pennage Security Policy

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

### All cattle born on or after 15<sup>th</sup> April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15<sup>th</sup> April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: to request permission.
