Another sizeable entry for which we thank all Vendors, met yet another cracking trade. No top drawer suckler cows to hit the highs of previous week's, however a well fleshed Angus from Mr DM Ruell achieved 116.5ppk, who also sold a Charolais at 110.5ppk. A good red, Limousin from Mr R Westlake rose to 112ppk, with another from the same farm at 111ppk. An Angus from Miss AM Bastable achieved 110.5ppk. Good sucklers to 106ppk. Meat 100ppk plus. Plain up to 100ppk depending how plain. Sucklers sold to £910.20 for a grand 820kg Limousin from Mr R Westlake. Others over £800 at £821.60, Charolais, Mr DW Parris; £812.35, Simmental, Mr WJ Ellicott and £808.64, Limousin, Mr R Westlake again. Black and whites a tremendous trade when all grades were extremely keenly contested. Top was 122.5ppk for a heifer from Messrs JA & P Healey & Major. Other heifers to 117ppk from Messrs MB & CJN Ayre and 107.5 and 106.5ppk from Messrs D & P Mead & Co. Cows rose to 113.5ppk for a peach of a Friesian from Messrs HC Derryman & Sons. A grand 834kg Holstein from Messrs RK & SG Miller & Sons sold particularly well at 111ppk. Other best black and whites at 108.5ppk, Messrs AC & MM Hopkins; 107ppk, Mr MA Pincombe; 105.5ppk and South Widcombe Dairy. Many good black and whites 100ppk plus. Meat cows 90ppk plus. Steakers 80 to 90ppk dependant on fill. Plain cows up to high 70's if empty, some of which again looked a monstrous price and the dearest sold again. Black and whites sold to £970.60 for a boat of a cow (920kg) from South Widcombe Dairy. Other tremendous cows over £900 at £939.36 from Mr N Herrod and £925.74 from Messrs RK & SG Miller & Sons. Several cows £800 plus and many £700 plus. One bull forward, Angus, from Mr RL Hebditch, which weighed 1025kg and sold at 95ppk. Once again we thank all Vendors for their kind support. More cows kindly requested to meet current demand. "Come to market for best prices."

Livestock Pennage Security Policy

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: to request permission.

Copy of written confirmation of STSS's permission to accompany stock to market with tags and taggers.
