Auctioneers Comments:

Wow! What a trade. A very tight entry of 151 prime cattle and yet again liveweight markets prove their worth. As predicted the third week of January was going to determine the Spring trade. We've seen that week off and the beef trade is on the up again. Deadweight was put up 2ppk and Sedgemoor is up 7ppk, approximately about 13ppk deadweight.

Come to market for best prices! Come to market to maintain control! Come to market to secure your future!

Top was 207.5ppk for a shapely, red Limousin heifer from Messrs RJ, HA & MR Popham, see (www.gth.net/gallery), who sold another similar at 203.5ppk. Very smart red heifers from Mr SJ Webber sold well at 199.0ppk, 196.5ppk and 195.5ppk. A run of good heifers from Messrs J & A Moon rose to 195.5ppk for a Simmental heifer, when another achieved 195ppk.

Other better heifers around 190ppk. Good heifers mid 180's. Commercial heifers high 170's.

Heifers sold to £1,457.28 for a tremendous Limousin (821kg) from Messrs J Richards & Son, who also sold a Blue heifer at £1,404.42 (789kg) and a Charolais at £1,379.92 (752kg). Several better heifers over £1200.

Steers peaked at 199.5ppk for a very shapely red Blonde from Messrs FG, NK & AJ Gammon. A quality black Limousin cross Friesian from Messrs FG Payne & Sons rose to 199ppk.

Well fed and exquisitely clipped for market. Other higher priced steers were a red Limousin from Messrs HJ Fisher and Andrew and Jonathan Gilding, again well clipped and 196.5ppk for another black dairy cross Limousin from Mr H Carnell.

Better steers also around 190ppk, good types mid 180's as well and commercial types similar to heifers in the high 170's.

Steers sold to £1,432.89 for a strong 783kg Blue from Messrs J & J Meaker & Son, who sold others similar at £1,402.25 and £1,359.63. Messrs FG, NK & AJ Gammon's Blonde steer realised £1,410.47 and the best of a run of Blue steers from Messrs Bailey Bros achieved £1,367.79. Several good steers £1300 plus.

Overage clean at little or no discount to £1,382.64 for a Charolais steer from Messrs TE & SJ Popham and £1,122.21 for a strong 666kg Montbeliarde heifer from Lordswood Farms.
