Auctioneers Comments:

An increased entry of just over 200 head, at 202 met a good trade, although not at last week's flying levels. Top was 211.5ppk for a shapely, black Limousin steer from Messrs CJ & JC Durston (www.gth.net/gallery) who also sold another quality red Limousin steer at 200.5ppk. A superb run of red Limousin steers from Mr AR Henson (all bred by Paula Curry) sold particularly well at 210.5ppk, 209.5ppk, 209ppk, 208ppk, 206.5ppk, 204.5ppk and 203.5ppk. A credit to both feeder and breeder. The best of a quality run of continental steers from Messrs AJ Hepper & Son peaked at 206.5ppk, with others at 200.5ppk, 200ppk and 198.5ppk. Best steers over 200ppk. Better types 180ppk plus, when lean feeding types were dearer. Good steers generally around 180ppk. Commercial straight sided steers mid 170's.

Steers sold to £1,475.73 for a grand 863kg Charolais from Messrs RM Sparks & Sons. Another over £1400 at £1,435.61 was a strong 842kg Blonde from Mr HJ Alford.

Heifers topped at 203ppk for a smart handyweight (510kg) Limousin from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners, who others at 202.5ppk and 195.5ppk (Limousins) and a Charolais at 202.5ppk. A shapely black Limousin cross Blue heifer from Messrs J & J Meaker & Son achieved 199ppk. Best heifers mid 190's. Better heifers generally 185ppk to 190ppk. Good heifers 175ppk to 180ppk. Commercial heifers around 170ppk.

Heifers sold to £1,322.58 for a tremendous 804kg Limousin from Messrs J Richards & Son, who sold another at £1,317.33.

A smart young Blue bull from Mr RE Hull returned at £1,031.30 (591kg at 174.5ppk).

OTM cattle to £1,250.66 for a strong 831kg Devon cross steer from Messrs RM Sparks & Sons and £1,250.20 for a deep fleshed Charolais heifer from Mr KLH Sweet.
