An almost identical entry in terms of numbers at 501 as the supply of store cattle remains very tight. "Are they there or are vendors holding to clear fodder?" is the question buyers are asking. Quality was generally much reduced, yet the overall average was only £10 back and trade was definitely dearer again. This could be the year to sell early as "closer the grass, cheaper the bullock" might be the situation. It will all depend on numbers.

Top was £1250 for a well fleshed Charolais steer (25m) from Mr BFW Rendell, Colyton. Another over £1200 was a covered Limousin steer (28m & FA) from Messrs Bishop & Son, South Perrott. A strong feeding Charolais steer (27m) from Mr KLH Sweet, Highbridge achieved £1190. Another good run of stores from Messrs EL Leigh & Son, Almondsbury peaked at £1155 (22m & FA). A forward store, Charolais steer (28m) from Mr B Tuck, Honiton sold well at £1098. Quality red, feeding Limousin steers (21m) from Messrs JA & G Aldworth, Hemyock met keen demand at £1065, £1060 and £1055. £1065 was also bid for 22m Limousin steers from Mr DK Weech. Another good run from Swaddledown Farms Ltd, Bratton Clovelly rose £1060 (19/20m & FA) with others 20m at £1045.

Native steers in exceptional demand on the native special sale. A well fleshed Angus from Mr TH Jeanes, North Curry sold particularly well at £1130 (28m). A shapely, Woodington sired Angus steer (22m & FA) from Mr PJ Huxtable, Bratton Fleming achieved £1088. £1065 was bid for smart Angus steers (16m) from Mr JA Crossman. Another good Angus steer at £1055 (20m) from Mr WF Pincombe, Chumleigh. Hereford steers sold to £1015 (23m) from Mr Tom Williams, Felton. Black and whites again in very keen demand to £1120 for overage steers from Mr DR House, Burrowbridge. Others to £970 (25m) from Mr JA Crossman again. A bunch from Messrs AC Dare & Partners, North Curry achieved £955.

Heifers over £1000 again to £1060 for a well fleshed 24m Limousin heifer from Messrs KC & SM Wilkinson, Wedmore. Close behind at £1055 was a smart Blue heifer (27m & FA) from Messrs RH & CM Johnson, Mappowder. £1030 was bid for a well fleshed Limousin (overage & FA) from Mr TH Jeanes again. Quality red feeding heifers (19/20m & FA) from Messrs MJK Reed & Son, Blackborough achieved £1025, who sold another £900 (20m). Charolais heifers peaked at £1000 (26m & FA) from Mr GA Heywood, Bideford. A Simmental from Messrs AC Dare & Partners again sold well at £980 (27m & FA) and a bunch of Blues (26m & FA) from Messrs RH & C Marchent, Bridgwater rose to £975.

Native heifers also over £1000 at £1030 for an Angus (20m) from Messrs FP Hill & Son, Clayhanger. Other good Angus heifers at £1010 (16/17m & FA) Messrs Bishop & Son again and £985 (22/23m & FA) from Mr PJ Huxtable again. Hereford heifers also over £1000 at £1010 (overage) for a well fleshed type from Mr TH Jeanes again.

Young stores in excellent demand to £1000 for a 12m Angus from Mr A Male & Son, Kingsbury Episcopi. Charolais cross Blues (11/12m) from Mr SJ Clist rose to £950. £950 was also bid for a superb 9m Limousin steer from Messrs KC & SM Wilkinson again.

Many feeding steers over £900 and many heifers over £800, which all looked very well sold. **The trade is definitely there now and it is a brave decision to hold until April.**

A strong entry of 272 beef calves found a consistently bright trade, very firm at the top end. Perhaps a shade easier for the mediums but still lively all day. Two outstanding older Limousin calves from Messrs RJ Tucker & Sons took the eye, when a bull achieved £446 and a heifer £418. A tremendous Simmental bull from Ireosa Ltd realised £412 and a pair of 10 week Herefords from Churchill Dairy Ltd sold at £400, one of the highest Hereford prices recorded in this section. Other Limousins to £385, £384, £382 Mr N George and Blues to £378 Twose Farms Ltd and £374 Messrs Palfrey. Over 50 calves topped £300, with most classy sorts in that bracket. Good younger bulls £240-£280, smaller bulls £170 plus.
