#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

A larger entry met a slightly easier trade after last weeks flier, when quality was generally in short supply. Top of the sale was 160.5ppk for a lightweight shapely Limousin steer, with time to feed, from Messrs HWC & JM Butler, who sold another similar type at 159ppk. Shape at a real premium with a lean, quality Limousin steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son at 158.5ppk, who sold a thicker Gelbvieh at 157.5ppk. Heifers also at 157.5ppk for a lean, shapely Limousin from Messrs FR & MJ Morrish. Selling for the first time at Sedgemoor, Mr G Glynn achieved 156ppk, 152ppk, 151.5ppk and 150.5ppk for four superb Blonde heifers. Other better conformation cattle over 150ppk at 154.5ppk, very lean Blonde from Messrs TV & E Wotton; 153ppk, well covered Charolais from Mr NE Richards; 152.5ppk, lean Limousin from Messrs CJ & JD Durston; 151.5ppk, lean Limousin from Mr JF Walker; 151ppk, lean Limousin from Mr RC Pike and 150.5ppk and 150ppk for smart butchers Simmentals from Messrs P & A White. Better cattle 140ppk plus. Straighter sided cattle mid thirties. Those lacking conformation, finish or too fat in the one twenties.

Several young bulls forward to 146ppk for a well shaped Hereford from Messrs R & B Boundy, with a good Limousin from Messrs GT & LA Lethbridge at 145ppk, who sold another 143ppk.

Overage peaked at 136ppk for a good British Blue from Mr RC Pike, with overage heifers to 134ppk for another smart Blue, this time from Mr JF Walker.

Steers sold to £1079.65 for a strong Limousin from Mr RC Pike, who sold another at £1072.19. Several others in excess of £1000. Heifers also over £1000 at £1057.68 for one of the Blondes from Mr G Glynn, who sold others at £1014.37, £992.33 and £945.44. Other better heifers £900 plus.

A larger number forward and trade continues to fall back as buyers complain of a lack of sales and poor exports on the back of a falling euro. Trade remains well ahead of the same week last year however, as well as being in front of other regional centres on Monday. Trade was helped by the attendance of 13 buyers purchasing for 17 different firms. The best lambs were 155ppk plus to top at 160ppk, 159ppk (x2) and 158ppk from Mr AAJ Bown. Others to 160ppk from Mr NCW Tavemor and Mr DA Kidner; 157ppk from Mr WS Stitch, Messrs HJ & HB Case Ltd and Messrs G Stacey & Sons and 155ppk from Mr JPT Scott, Mr RD Willcox, Mr RJ Smith and Messrs TE & SJ Popham. The best quality heavier lambs were £68 plus to top at £75.50 and £70 from Mr J White. Others to £75.50 from Mr MJ Britton; £75 from Mr WS Stitch and Mr RH Hill; £72.80 from Messrs HWC & JM Butler; £72.50 and £69 from Mr RE Webber; £70 from Mr C Reasons; £69.50 from Messrs W Moore & Sons; £68.80 from Mr RC Pike and £68.50 from Mr MM Field. Overall average £62.19.
