A tight entry again when trade was just a shade easier, yet still very keenly sought for the time of year and against the clean cattle. Top was 125.5ppk for a Limousin heifer from Mr ER Gillbard, who sold another at 112.5ppk. A thick Angus heifer from Messrs JR Dill & Son rose to 111ppk. Suckler cows peaked at 111ppk for a shapely red Limousin cow from Mr ER Gillbard again. Others to 108ppk for a lean feeding Simmental from Mr RH Gibson. Other leaner sucklers around the pound. Black and whites topped at 103.5ppk for a young cow from Messrs WP Gange & Son. Other young well fleshed cows at 99.5 and 95ppk from Mr RJ Rowe. Older cows rose to 98.5ppk from Mr N Herrod, with another from the same farm at 93.5ppk. The best of a good run of strong cows from Mr RJ Rowe sold to 94.5ppk, with another at 93.5ppk. 93.5ppk was also received by Messrs RH & C Marchent. Better meat cows generally around 90ppk. Three quarter meat in the 80's and plain steakers in the 70's. Again a very strong trade for very plain grade 4's, with most up and down of 60ppk. Black and white heifers to 100.5ppk from Messrs J & H Sexton, with another at 94.5ppk from Messrs RW Partridge & Sons. Sucklers sold to £958.19 for a grand 963kg South Devon from Mrs J Duncan. Others to £735.38 for a lean, shapely Charolais from Messrs McEwen Smith. Black and whites sold to £750.33 from Mr RJ Rowe, who sold others at £738.65 and £704.46. A tremendous 822kg cow from Finefarm Ltd achieved £735.69. Other best cows over £700 from Messrs JR Dill & Son at £726.74 and £713.32. £702.63 was received by Mr N Herrod. A tremendous Limousin bull from Messrs M Harrison & Partners sold well at £1008 and a grand Holstein from Mr RJ Rowe achieved £816.40. Again more cows could have been sold to advantage and we continue to recommend Vendors clear barreners ahead of the fall.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.

If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
