A tremendous July market, when 862 store cattle, sucklers and stirks were penned. A new centre record was set by Mrs C Long, Lutterworth, for store cattle, with a 14m pure black Limousin heifer, which sold for an exceptional price of £1460. Congratulations and well done. Another store over £1200 was a grand 28m red Angus steer from Mr ME Lewis, Alveston at £1250. Strong black Limousin steers, 24m from Messrs CS, SE & MP Pyke, Backwell, achieved £1150. Charolais steers peaked at £1090 (25m) from Mr C Long again, with another (25m) at £970 from Mr A Burland, Spaxton. Simmental steers rose to £1050 (24m) from Mr GS Boobyer, Cullompton. Others £1010 (22m) from Messrs SA & E Friswell, Rugby, and £980 (24m) Mr A Burland again. Other Limousin steers at £990 (27m and FA) Messrs F & EJ Strawbridge, Axminster and £975 (24m) Mr A Burland again. Blue steers also at £975 (25m and FA) from Messrs AF, VA & NA Maynard, Awliscombe.

After the £1250 Angus, other native steers rose to £955 (26m/27m) from Mr DJ Prouse, Woodbury, with another Angus steer at £945 (24m) from Messrs RL Jones & Sons, Wiveliscombe. A price of note was £940 for a 20m Beef Shorthorn steer from Messrs S & J Willis, Dunball.

Black and white steers still in good demand to £905 (21m and FA) from Mr T Blackshire, St Austell, who sold a Swedish Red at £892 (22m) and a Swedish Black at £890. Other Holsteins to £870 (52m and FA) from Messrs WL Persey & Sons, Blackborough.

Heifers also well over £1000 at £1115 for an outstanding red Limousin, 24m, from Mr AP Withecombe, Appledore, who also sold very well fleshed Charolais heifers (23m) at £1045. Pure bred Simmental heifers from Mr JT Andrews, Brompton Regis, achieved £995 (35m) and £990 (26m). A fleshed Charolais from Mr A Burland again sold well at £955. Very well bred feeding Charolais heifers (14m/19m and FA) from Mr PA Cleave, Bude shot to £930. A fit 25m Angus from Mr ME Lewis again realised £920. Another Limousin heifer (26m and FA) rose to £885 from Messrs F & EJ Strawbridge & Sons again. The same price was bid for a 22m Charolais heifer from Mr RA Helmer, Kingsbridge. Young 14m/16m Charolais heifers from Mrs SM Harvey, Plymouth sold exceptionally well at £875. Mrs C Long also scored with other Limousin heifers (19m) at £868.

After the new centre record of £1460, young stores sold to £915 for 14m Charolais steers from Mr PA Cleave again, who sold others 10m at £870. £900 was bid for a 15m Limousin steer from Messrs JA & G Aldworth, Hemyock. A super run from Messrs EJ Browse & Son, Halberton, all 14m Charolais steers achieved £865, £815, £825 and £800. 15m South Devon steers from Mr CR Wyatt, Chard sold well at £855.

Our grateful thanks go to all Vendors for their gracious support. At a time when store cattle are in short supply, to amass an entry close to 600, with Vendors as far reaching as St Austell, Carmarthen, West Sussex, Coventry and Rugby, it is truly gratifying. Numbers bring buyers and when centre records are set, buyers are evidently in attendance. Others £365, £350 Messrs Hoskins & Vickery; £346 Messrs PG, ME & SE Harvey. Charolais bulls to £330 Messrs Bowles and Limousins also £330, when Simmentals advanced to £325 Holmwood Farms Ltd.

A lot of decent bulls £250-£300, in good demand with mediums generally £220 plus, plainer bulls £150-£200.
