Auctioneers Comments:

Another strong entry at Sedgemoor, particularly for June as the grass cattle start to come on stream. Some real quality forward, crowned by an absolute best British Blue heifer from Messrs SM & D Skinner of Shebbear, which weighed 560kg and met a final call of 174.5ppk to return at £977.20. Another similar Blue heifer from the same farm, 680kg achieved 162ppk and £1101.60. Steers from Messrs SM & D Skinner also broke the 170ppk barrier at 170.5ppk, being a British Blonde, 600kg and £1023. Another steer over £1000 from the Skinners was a classy lean Blonde at £1000.62, being 612kg and 163.5ppk. More smart Blonde steers, still from David and family sold particularly well at 158.5ppk (625kg and £990.63); 158ppk (583kg and £921.14) and 158ppk again (573kg and £905.34). Also in the top money was Mr SER Hunt at 162.5ppk (510kg and £828.75) for a barley Blue heifer, with another 456kg at 159.5ppk and £727.32. A well bred run of quality homebred cattle from Mr BA Richards peaked at 162ppk for a lean, shapely Charolais (636kg and £1030.32). Other grand homebred Limousins from the same farm topped the pounds per head at £1157.10, £1149.04, £1112.48 and £1083.76. A good run of Charolais heifers, this time from Messrs L & F Maddock & Son rose to 161.50ppk (552kg and £891.48). The best of Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners' sold well at

159ppk for a lean, shapely Limousin heifer. The same price was bid for a cracker, being a Blonde steer from Mr RC Pike (£1001.70).

Natives peaked at 157.5ppk for a very smart Angus steer from Messrs CJ & JLM Hutchings. Many better types 150ppk plus from Mr RJ Smith, Mr & Mrs EB & JA Webber; Mr & Mrs CJ & JC Durston; Messrs CWH & HP Northmore; Mr RWG Chilcott; Mr RD Cox; Messrs Bailey Bros and Mr RE Webber.

Other big money steers at £1135.90 for a Limousin from Messrs CJ & JC Durston. Others to £1098.53, Blue, Messrs RW & SJ Gay and £1097.10, Charolais, Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem. Many steers £1000 plus. Other heifers over £1000 at £1020.20 for a Blue from Messrs RW & SJ Gay. Many £900 plus.

Some better young bulls on offer, lead by two Simmentals and a blue from Messrs R & B Boundy at 149ppk, 148.5ppk and 144.5ppk being twelve and thirteen months and good weights of 626kg, 614kg and 674kg. They returned at £932.74, £911.79 and £973.93. Good Friesian bulls from Mr PB Dibble sold well at 119.5ppk, 117ppk, 155ppk and 113.5ppk.

Overage still very keenly sought at 141.5ppk for a Blue heifer from Messrs Bailey Bros and 140ppk for a Limousin steer from Messrs DJ Hill & Partners. Overage sold to £1005.55 for a grand 845kg Blue steer from Messrs Quick & Sons, with heifers to £847.36 for a Simmental from Mr EJ Gay. Many thanks once again to all vendors for such a quality show. With no waiting list and a trade unmatched in the South of England, live or dead, can you afford not to sell at Sedgemoor?

With a good company of buyers many more would have sold to advantage. The overall quality was first class.
