A tight summer entry on a real hay making weekend, met a continued strong trade, particularly when assessed against current deadweight prices and grass stocks. Plenty of strength on offer, which drew strong competition to £970 for grand forward 21m Charolais steers from Messrs WJ & RA Alford, Craddock, who also sold a 21m Limousin at £940 and 21m Charolais at £930.

A tremendous run of feeding steers from Norbin Farm Ltd, Box, sold well at £960 for 27m Limousins and 26/27m Charolais. Also from the same farm, 24/27m Charolais at £920, 25/26m Blues at £880, 25m Simmental at £880 and 27m Limousin also at £880. A superb run of 38 and a real credit. A well grown Charolais 22m from Mr RC Pike, Axminster also achieved £920. Four smart red Limousin steers from Messrs M & JM Drew, Pilning, sold readily at £910 for 25m, £885 for 25m and £880

for 26m. Another steer in the money at £895 was a 25m Limousin from Ms KM Hoskyns, Knowstone. Plenty of stronger steers £850 plus, including a 25m Angus at £860 from Norbin Farm Ltd again. Hereford steers peaked at £845 for a well fleshed 23m type from Mr R L Potbury, Combe Raleigh. Others £795, 26m from Norbin Farm Ltd again.

Heifers rose to £845 for two superb, shapely 17m Blondes from Mr & Mrs GH & MG Barber. Fleshed heifers to £800 twice from both Mr RM Baggs, Long Bredy, 24m Simmental and Mr PJ Batstone, Chilthorne Damer, 28m Simmental. A smart white Blue 23m from Mr JB Clist, Hemyock, achieved £780. Fleshed heifers 13/16m from Mr RC Pike again sold well at £770. Native heifers sold to £760 for two strong 28m, fleshed Angus from Messrs RW & GH Jarrett, Tiverton.

Young stores peaked at £730 for a good 14m Charolais steer from Mr J Binnie, Taunton. Quality Blonde heifers 13/16m from Mr GH & Mrs MG Barber again rose to £702. £700 was bid for a 14m Blue steer from Messrs BM Commbes & Son, Blackford.

Some better black and whites forward. A three quarter meat 27m Friesian from Mr RC Pike again achieved £755. Leaner Holsteins, 20/22m from Messrs AJ, S & CJ Franks, Blakeway at £685, as were 23/24m red and white Friesians from Mr RL Potbury again. A price of note was £842 for a strong 22m Montbeliarde, also from Mr RL Potbury.
