Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a larger entry than expected, which was well up on last year's numbers and met another good trade and interestingly averaged at exactly the same level as last year at £602. Top of the sale was £930 for a superb 15m Blue steer from Mr RF Spiller.

Strong steers at and over £900 at £920 for forward 24/26m farm assured Charolais from Messrs PH & ME Buckingham, Brompton Regis and £900 for well grown 25m farm assured Limousin steers from Mr CJ Chant, Bower Hinton. Smart farm assured 25/26m Limousin steers from Messrs J & J Meaker & Son achieved £872, with another from the same farm, 23m at £865. A well grown 24m, farm assured feeding Charolais from Mr & Mrs Cr & SL Pople, Burtle, achieved £860. Heifers peaked at £850 for two quality, shapely Blondes, 17/19m and farm assured from Messrs GH & MG Barber, Crediton. Fleshed heifers to £795 for a 21m Charolais from Mr N Woodman, Huish Episcopi. Others £790, 22m shapely, lean black Limousin from Mr JLD Burrough & Son, Wambrook and £785, for a smart bunch of 10 Angus out of South Devons, 26/28m from Mr A Bennett, Cadeleigh. The best of a good run of heifers from Messrs McEwen Smith, Henbury, rose to £780 for a 25m Hereford. Angus in the monthly sale sold well as ever to £828 for a bunch of 8 20/24m farm assured steers from Messrs LF & JM Heywood, Loxbeare, who sold others at £800. Herefords, also in the Monthly Sale achieved £795 for 25/26m farm assured steers from Mr & Mrs CR & SL Pople again. Others £785 for 23/26m farm assured steers from Messrs DB & A Fry, Bridport. Black and whites to £730 for a well fleshed overage heifer from Messrs WJ Venn & Son, Bishops Hull. Proper Friesian steers, 19/24m and farm assured at £728 from Messrs LF & JM Heywood again. Others at £698 for 26m farm assured steers from Mr AC Rich, Ilminster and £658 for 21/22m. Holsteins from Mr N Woodman again. Young stores to £840 for a 17m Blue steer, farm assured, from Messrs AJ Scott & Son, Wells. 17m Angus steers at £750 from Messrs A Male & Son, Kingsbury Episcopi. 13m farm assured Charolais steers at £730 from Mr & Mrs CR & SL Pople again, who sold others, 11/13m at £720. Young heifers to £675 for 15/17m Simmentals from Messrs AA Whitcombe & Son, Compton Dundon. Others to £665 for 16/17m Blue heifers, farm assured, from Messrs AJ Scott & Son again. Overage rose to £840 for a 34m farm assured Limousin steer from Messrs P Harris & Snell, South Molton.

Still a strong trade, particularly when considering how grass stocks have shrunk this last week and how light first cuts have been, with second cuts still a matter of hope. Farm assured stock in the vanguard and a must if stock over 26 months.
