Yet again a tight entry but what a trade! Now is the time to sell barreners as demand is red hot. Another top drawer black Limousin from Messrs AJ & MJ Williams & Saunders crowned the sale again at 139.5ppk. An exceptional cow. A well fleshed young Blue cow from Messrs FE Hill & Son achieved 127ppk. 120.5ppk was bid for an exceptional Angus from Mr & Mrs A Brown. Other better sucklers 115ppk and over. Meat types around 105 to 110ppk and plain sucklers 90 to 100ppk. Coloured cows sold £1029.07 for the 854kg Angus from Mr & Mrs Brown. The Limousin cross from Messrs AJ & MJ Williams & Saunders £970.92. A few £800 plus and many in the £700s. Black and whites as dear as seen all year and sold to 116ppk for a best type from Messrs MS & NM Hebditch. Young cows at 112.5 and 108.5ppk from Messrs C Read Partnership. Other good meat older cows 110ppk, Messrs D & M Legg & Sons; 109ppk, Mr GC Vowles and 107.5ppk Mr PD Gooding. Many meat cows 100 to 105ppk. Meat and belly mid nineties. Steakers 85 to 92ppk. Only very plain cows with big bellies, or skin and bones 60ppk plus. Black and whites sold to £910 from Messrs MW Nash & Partners, with another over £900 at £902.52 from Messrs AJ, S & CJ Franks. Others to 183p for 39kg at £71.20 from Arscott Farms who also sold 39kg at £70. Others 38kg to £66.80 Mr NW Payne. Good runs from Messrs AJ & MJ

Williams & Saunders and a lovely pen of 41kg 12 week lambs from Messrs DJ Burrough & Son to £71.80. More interest at the heavy end with 52kg to £88 Mr MH Wallis and 49kg at £85 Mrs J Barrett. Others to £84.50 Mr RJ Farrenden. A handful of hogs of variable types sold to a top price of £65 Messrs WN Chick & Sons. Others to £63.50, £62.50 and £60.

Greenslade Taylor Hunt, Sedgemoor Auction Centre Livestock Pannage Security Policy

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pannage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.

If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission. Copy of written confirmation of STSS's permission to accompany stock to market with tags and taggers.
