A slightly reduced entry of generally leaner cows met another strong trade. A real shortage of meat and no absolute best cows forward. Sucklers sold to 114.5ppk for a young Charolais from Messrs AR & JL Denning. 114ppk was bid for a lean but shapely Blue cross from Chargot Estate. Other three quarter meat coloured cows at 108ppk for a Devon from Mr PA Huxtable; 107.5ppk for a South Devon from Mr CR Wyatt and 107ppk for an Angus from Messrs RW & JE Tucker. Several other three quarter meat cows 103 to 106.5ppk. Grazers around the one pound mark and keenly sought. Black and whites peaked at 108ppk for a smart type from Messrs A & DM Dennis & Son. A young cow achieved 107.5ppk from Messrs PC Pocock & Co. Better types then 102ppk, Messrs RF & BA Larcombe; 101.5 and 99.5ppk Messrs F & EJ Strawbridge & Sons and 97.5ppk Messrs Symes Partners. Meat cows 90 to 95ppk. Steakers 80 to 90ppk. Quite plain cows in the 70's. The dearest and most keenly contested were 60 to 70ppk, being very plain types and well sold on the current buoyant trade. The effects of the recent dry spell and shortage of grass are beginning to show on the cows as it was the leanest entry of cows seen for some while. However trade is good and cows are better sold than held and fed, to be brought out onto what might be a falling trade in the back end. Big cows returned the money when the South Devon (835kg) from Mr CR Wyatt achieved £897.63. £894.60 was received by Mr JA Naish for a grand 840kg Charolais. A tremendous 942kg Holstein Friesian from Messrs CE & BD Bailey realised £861.93, with another from the same farm at £833.72. Best cows £800 plus. Plenty £700 plus. A handful of bulls and clean all well sold. More barreners kindly requested to satisfy current demand, particularly plain cows for northern feed.

Others to 168ppk from Mr B Scriven; 165 and 161ppk from Mr MJ Pidsley; 162 and 161ppk from Messrs L Habberfield & Sons and 160ppk from Mr BJ Beaver, Messrs JR Westcott & Son, Mr CD Byrne and Mr DJ Spratt. The best quality heavier lambs were £70 plus to top at £79.50 from Mr KM Burrough; £78.80 from Mr B Scriven; £73 and £71 from Mr BS Garrett; £72.50 and £70.50 from Mr MJ Pidsley; £70.50 from Pittard Partners and £70.20 from Mr BJ Beaver.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.

If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission. Copy of written confirmation of STSS's permission to accompany stock to market with tags and taggers.
