More are desperately needed to meet the current very strong demand. Coloured cows sold to 140.5ppk for a young best Blue from Messrs AJ & MJ Williams & Saunders, who also sold a young Limousin to 131.5ppk. Good meat young Devons from Messrs G Dart & Son achieved 118 and 115.5ppk. Well fleshed older sucklers to 114.5ppk twice (Limousin) Messrs O & K Cook and (Simmental) Messrs M Harrison & Partners. Good types 107ppk plus. Coloured steakers around 100ppk. Coloured cows sold to £889.67 for a strong Simmental from Messrs M Harrison & Partners. £861.33 was received by Messrs AJ & MJ Williams & Saunders. Best coloured cows generally over £800. Black and whites red hot again. Top price was 113.5ppk for the best of a grand run from Mr RJ Rowe, who sold others at 111.5, 106.5 and 99.5ppk. 110ppk was achieved by Messrs ND & RA Pearce. Young cows rose to 111.5ppk also from Messrs WT Harding & Sons, with another at 109ppk from Messrs Coombe Farming. Better cows 100ppk plus. Meat cows 90 to 100ppk. Steakers 85 to 90ppk. Only plain cows under 80ppk and they had to be poor to be under 70ppk. Black and whites heifers to 108ppk from Messrs F & S Aplin, with another at 104ppk from Messrs JR Dill & Son. Black and whites sold to £895.50 from Mr RJ Rowe, who sold others at £849.63, £806.21 and £805.85. £817.65 was received by Messrs DJ Hill & Partners. Better cows all over £700, including the heifer from Messrs JR Dill & Son at £790.40.  A large entry, which met an easier trade. Weight suffered least when heavier medium weight or heavy yellow lambs met best demand for the wholesale and butcher trade. Top of the day was £86 for 46 kilos from Messrs AF & RD Tucker & Sons. Others to £85.50 (47kg) from Messrs RP & PJ Lowman, £85.50 again (45kg) from Mr ML Mackie and £85 (51kg) from Messrs LD & GA Norman. 44kg plus generally £80 plus. Top pence per kilo at 201ppk for 39kg from both Messrs RM & BJ Norman (£78.50) and Messrs HJ & HB Case Ltd (£78.20). Others 195ppk (38kg at £74) from Mr LJ Vowles and 193ppk (40kg at £77) from Mr WT Hodges. Too many lambs offered in a too lean condition. It looks like its time to get the cake bag out as many lambs show the signs of a lack of grass. Too many lean lambs below 40 kilos in the £60s. 41kg near guaranteed £70, so 40kg plus has to be the target weight. After recent gains by the pound, the pound against the euro has started to weaken as Fitch (credit rating agency) warned the UK faced a "formidable" challenge to cut its

budget deficit. (08/06/2010) The stop of the strengthening of the pound, which makes exports less favourable, will hopefully encourage exporters. Very small entry of hogs sold to £73.50 for 45kg (163ppk) from Messrs CD & BH Persey. Others to £70 for 50kg from Messrs RP Waldron & Loveridge and 64kg from Mr RJ Farenden.

 Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.
 In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence.
