Auctioneers Comments:

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a slightly larger entry and another good show, which sold to a continuing very strong trade.

Top was 187ppk for an absolute best red Limousin steer from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at 182ppk, 181ppk, 180ppk and 178.5ppk twice. An outstanding run and a tremendous achievement. Another top drawer run of red Limousin steers this time from Messrs JE & M Mather & Son peaked at 186.5ppk, with others at 186ppk and 183ppk twice. Another tremendous effort. Other best steers over 180ppk came forward from Messrs TV & E Wotton, whose Limousins achieved 184ppk and 183ppk, with a Charolais from the same farm at 178.5ppk.

Heifers also over 180ppk at 180.5ppk for a top drawer red Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold another similar Gelbvieh this time overage at 179.5ppk and a UTM Limousin heifer at 173ppk. Other best heifers at 179ppk for a Limousin from Messrs TV & E Wotton and for a Blue from Mr MT Westaway. 177.5ppk was bid for a Charolais from Messrs M & J Gibbins. The best of a run of Charolais heifers from Mr BA Richards achieved 173ppk with others at 172.5ppk and 172ppk. Barley Blue heifers from Mr SER Hunt peaked at 172ppk, with a Limousin at 171ppk. The best from Messrs RG & A Pearce, being Limousin cross Angus sold well at 172ppk and a Limousin from Mr MC Bailey achieved 171.5ppk.

Very best steers and heifers generally 180ppk plus. Better types 170ppk plus. Good steers and heifers mid 160's with straighter sided types mid 150's. Only those with belly, small and fat or lacking any shape below 150ppk.

Overage clean after Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son's Gelbvieh heifer rose to 159.5ppk for a Limousin steer from Mr MT Westaway. Other overage heifers to 154ppk for a Limousin from Mr RW Darby.

Steers sold to £1,281.00 for a 732kg Limousin from Mr AR Henson, who sold others at £1,254.86 and £1,231.65. Other steers over £1,200 from Messrs G Vauden & Sons at £1,267.73, Limousin; Messrs TV & E Wotton at £1,256.64 and £1,222.11, both Charolais; Messrs FJ Webber & Son at £1,247.29, Charolais; Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son at £1,233.09, Gelbvieh; Messrs AJ Hepper & Son at £1,230.44, Limousin; Messrs L & FJA Christopher at £1,218.71, Charolais and Messrs CJ Radford & Son at £1,218.08, Limousin. OTM steers over £1200 at £1,260.73 for an Angus from Mr JM Cload & Partners and £1,223.98 for another Angus from Messrs AG Hicks & Son.

Heifers sold to £1,176.60 for a Charolais from Mr BA Richards, who sold another at £1,104.00. Other heifers over £1100 from Mr PJ Patch at £1,131.60, Blue and Messrs FJ Webber & Son at £1,124.24 and £1,115.55, Charolais. Overage heifers to £1,132.96 for an Angus from Mr JM Cload & Partners, when others from Mr MR Lee sold at £1,112.96, £1062 and £1003, Limousin.

Our grateful thanks to all vendors for their continued support. Trade remains favourable and those who come forward were rewarded.
