#### Auctioneers Comments:

A very tight entry of finished cattle met a dearer trade, when many more could have been sold to advantage. Overall quality was no match for that of last week's, yet the averages were improved indicating the strength of the trade.

Top was 183.5ppk for a shapely Blonde form Messrs Bottor Rock Farms, who sold other better type Blonde steers at 179.5ppk, 179ppk (x2), 178ppk and 172ppk. The best of a run of barley cattle from Mr SER Hunt achieved 181.5ppk for a Blue steer, when another from the same farm achieved 175ppk. Other continental steers over 170ppk were a Charolais from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners at 174.5ppk and a Blue from Messrs WH Amesbury & Son at 171ppk. Native steers also at the 170ppk mark for a Hereford from Mrs N Cottrell at 170.5ppk and an Angus from Messrs REW & RJ Tucker at 169.5ppk. Good steers mid to high 160's. Straighter sided steers around 160ppk, including three O-Friesian steers from Mr R Saunders at 152.0ppk (x2) and 151.0ppk.

Heifers topped at 179.5ppk for another shapely Blonde from Bottor Rock Farms, who sold another at 173ppk. A smart red Limousin from Messrs JS & M Frost rose to 178ppk. A well fleshed black Limousin from Messrs FG Payne & Sons sold well at 177.5ppk. The best of a run of heavy heifers from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son achieved 175ppk. Lightweight red Limousin heifers from Messrs RJ & AM Pedrick achieved 173.5ppk and 170ppk. Shapely Blue heifers from both Mr AM Doble and Mr SER Hunt sold well at 172.5ppk, as did a Blonde from Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners, who sold another at 170.5ppk. Good heifers also mid to high 160's. Straighter sided types also around 160ppk.

Steers sold to £1,287.20 for a tremendous black Limousin from Messrs CJ Radford & Son. Other strong steers over £1250 were a Charolais from Mr BA Richards at £1,259.60 and a Simmental from Mr RG Speed at £1,254.05. Several others £1200 plus.

Heifers sold to £1,182.55 for a Charolais from Messrs RJS Winslade & Son, who sold another at £1,116.50. Other heifers over £1050 were a Charolais from Messrs F & M House & Son at £1,069.77 and a Blonde from Bottor Rock Farms at £1,050.08. Better heifers £950 plus.

Two young Angus bulls forward from Messrs MR & SK Westcott, which both achieved 143.5ppk and returned at £1,057.60 and £958.58.

Overage clean very keenly sought to 168.5ppk for a Limousin heifer form Messrs ML & EE Edwards. A Blue heifer from Messrs McEwen Smith achieved 165.5ppk and the best of a run of Limousin heifers from Mr RG Wall sold to 163ppk, with others at 162ppk and 161.5ppk.

Overage clean sold to £1,197.70 for a Holstein Friesian steer from Messrs SGE Hatch & Son and £1,171.59 for an Angus heifer from Messrs McEwen Smith.
