An increased entry of 620 store cattle met another strong trade. Albeit not quite as fast as last week's flyer as more numbers came forward, yet still an excellent trade.

Top was £1095 for a strong Limousin steer (25m) from Mr AJ Pauley, Bridport who also sold a pair of 24/25m Charolais at £980 and a good 24m Charolais at £938. Strong Charolais steers (23m) from Messrs D Wyatt & Son, Axminster achieved £1075. The best of a good run, Farm Assured (FA) from Messrs JC & FF Dovey, Dorchester peaked at £1070 for a forward 23m Simmental steer. Other Simmentals from Messrs RP & SJ Chaplin, Yatton sold well at £1055 (21m and FA). A 25m Limousin rig from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet, Burtle met a final call of £1030 and an average Limousin steer from Mrs JE Clapp, Brendon Hill achieved £1005. Better continental steers generally £900 plus.

Native steers rose to £980 for a well fleshed Hereford (21m) from Messrs A Bragg & E Jennings, South Molton. Angus steers topped at £920 (28m and FA) from Mr RL Potbury, Combe Raleigh, with another 25m at £898 from Messrs EJ Rockett & Son, Wambrook.

Black and white steers sold to £848 twice for a bunch (24m/25m and FA) from Mr DJ Clarke, Thornbury and a bunch (21m/22m and FA) from Messrs M & B Humphry, Isle Abbots. Other forward black and white steers achieved £835 (24m) from Messrs NW & SE Legg & Son, South Perrott.

Forward heifers in excellent demand to £975 for a strong Blonde (24m and FA) from Mr FW Brown, North Molton. A shapely Blue (22m and FA) from Messrs JC & FF Dovey again rose to £965, who also sold Simmentals (22m) at £870 and another Blue (21m) at £862. Charolais from Mrs M Bover, Weymouth rose to £870 (22m and FA). Charolais heifers from Mr RL Potbury again sold well at £858 and another over £850 was a fleshed Limousin (23m) from Mr RD Withers, Truro at £855. Native heifers sold to £835 for a 25m grass fed Angus from Messrs Lynham and Chidgey, Woolavington. £830 was bid for a fleshed Hereford (24m) from Mr BC Knapp and another Angus (26m) this time from Messrs EJ Rockett & Son again, achieved £825. Better heifers generally £800 plus.

Young stores in keen demand to £940 for a tremendous (13m and FA) Limousin steer from Messrs B Stanley & Sons, Bridgend, who sold other best steers (13m and FA) at £850 and a forward 13m Limousin heifer at £835. A 13m Limousin rig from Messrs CL, AE & RC Sweet again achieved £930. A good run of Charolais steers (15m/16m) from Mr JD Meyrick sold well at £870, £835, £822 and £815. 13/14m Blonde steers (FA) from Mr FW Brown again achieved £865. Very young stores, 8m/9m and FA from Messrs RW & BA Bellamy, Peter Tovey met excellent demand for shapely Blue cross steers at £785 and £718 and heifers at £775, £660 and £650.

Many thanks to all vendors, particularly those who rang in to advise of their intended stock details, for their continued support to enable a strong entry, which attracted buyers from Sussex, Buckinghamshire, Oxford, Glamorgan, Shropshire, Norfolk and Yorkshire, as well as many from the South West.
