A good entry of over 800 store cattle and stirks for the first week of June, when many farmers were busy with silage and now hay making to take advantage of the continuing fine weather. Trade for the stronger types still very firm but for younger plainer types more selective. Top price was £1075 for a well fleshed 24m Charolais steer from Messrs AR Copp & Partners, Beaminstor. The best of a good run from Messrs RM Farming Co, St Austell, peaked at £1010 for a 26m Simmental steer and with Limousin steers from the same Vendors to £970. Other Charolais steers topped at £975 (22m) for the first of a good run from Messrs J Cole & Son, Ivybridge, whose younger sorts at 10-14m sold well at £775 and £760. A smart 19m British Blue from Messrs WL Persey & Son, Blackborough sold for £962 and a fleshy Devon steer made £900 from Mr T Gabriel, Kentisbeare.

Native breeds topped at £965 for a smart 21m Angus steer from Messrs MK & SK Westcott, Porlock, closely followed by the best of a good show of suckler bred Angus steers from Messrs McEwen Smith of Henbury at £935, with others to £898. Messrs Copp & Partners also topped the Herefords at £925 for a 26m steer and an outstanding 24m Friesian steer from the same Vendor made £958. Other Friesians to £832 (O/A) from Messrs W & EA Tratt, Luppitt and £760 for a pair of 26m from Messrs GF & DV Bussell, Sampford Arundel.

Messrs Copp & Partners also secured the top priced heifer at £1005 for a 27m Charolais. Hereford heifers to £920 from Mr RA Reed. An overage Simmental heifer from Mr A Kift, Kentisbury sold well at £870. Overage Limousin from Messrs Tratt at £855, overage Belgian from Mr CA Churchill at £795 and £900 for an Angus from Mr HH Lawrence, Ottery St Mary. A good run of well fleshed Angus heifers from Messrs BM Heal & Son, West Pennard sold to £872, with others at £870, £810. A sharp trade for the younger suckler bred stores to £880 for a superb pair of red Limousin steers (18m) from Mr JP Tolley, Chard. £850 was bid for an outstanding pair of 14m Charolais steers from Messrs RE & CF White, Bishopswood, who sold others at £770 and £710 for a 10m steer. 17m Limousin steer at £805 from Mrs BGF Duddridge, Bathpool. 13-15m Charolais steers to £790 from Mr MR Scott, Watchet who also sold 14-15m heifers at £755. 16m Simmental steer at £712 Mr RCM Facey, Cornwall. £690 for 10-13m Limousin steers from Messrs CF & WE Richens, Totnes and £675 for 12-15m Limousins from Messrs WJ Acreman & Son, Gloucester. Included within a good run of well grown Angus steers from Mr RA Reed, Seaton was a bunch of 13-18m month at £835.
