#### Auctioneers Comments:

Another tight entry of 177 prime cattle after the Bank Holiday, met  
another strong trade. Some very smart cattle on show again to a top of  
183ppk for a top drawer Limousin from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son.  
Best red Limousin steer from Mr AR Henson to 182.5ppk, with others  
from the same farm at 182ppk, 181.5ppk, 178ppk (x2), 177.5ppk and  
175.5ppk. Other best steers, again shapely red Limousin steers at  
179ppk, 176.5ppk and 174.5ppk from Messrs JE & M Mather & Son.  
Better shaped steers into the 160ppk's. Good types high 150's. Straight  
sided steers around 150ppk.

Heifers peaked at 174ppk twice for barley Blues from Mr SER Hunt, who  
sold others at 168ppk and 165.5ppk. A quality run of shapely heifers  
from Messrs TV & E Wotton achieved 173.5ppk, 169ppk and 166ppk, all  
Limousins. Another quality Limousin heifer, this time from  
Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners met a call of 172.5ppk. Other best heifers  
sold well at 170ppk, Limousin from Mr R Adams; 169.5ppk Blonde  
Messrs L & F Maddock & Son and 166.5ppk, Simmental from  
Messrs R & B Boundy. Better heifers also up and down of 160ppk. Good  
heifers mid 150's. Straighter sided types high 140's.  
Some smart young bulls forward from Messrs Dyer & Co, being Blues,  
which achieved 160.5ppk and 157.5ppk. These returned at £1,051.28  
and £1,034.78.

Best steers all over £1200 to £1,301.08 for a Limousin from  
Mr AR Henson, who sold others at £1,274.13, £1,271.59 and £1,258.34.  
Best heifers over £1000 to £1,128.12 for a strong 714kg Charolais from  
Messrs FJ Webber & Son. Others over £1100 at £1,115.52, Charolais,

from Messrs TV & E Wotton and £1,100.55, Blue, from  
Messrs SW Batten & Sons.

OTM cattle in short supply and very keenly sought to 167.5ppk for a top  
drawer Limousin steer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son. Steers  
returned up to £1,181.75 for a Blue from Messrs SW Batten & Sons.  
OTM heifers peaked at 148.5ppk for a Blue from  
Messrs SW Batten & Sons and £960.30 for an Angus from  
Messrs MR & SK Westcott.
