Auctioneers Comments:

An excellent entry, close to 300 head again at 285, of well finished cattle for which vendors must be thanked and congratulated. All types very dear to a top of 185ppk for a shapely, plum, black Limousin from Mr J Bendle. Other best heifers to 173ppk, well fleshed Blue, Messrs WH Amesbury & Son; 172ppk well fleshed Blue, Mr SER Hunt; 172ppk shapely red Limousin, Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners; 172ppk very shapely Charolais Mr RE Webber and 170.5ppk, lean, shapely Limousin from Messrs J & DJ Cotterill. Better type heifers 160ppk plus. Good heifers mid 150's. Straighter sided heifers mid to high 140's.

Heifers sold to £1,142.35 for a strong Charolais from Messrs SJ & EH Coles. Other strong heifers over £1100 at £1,130.40, Charolais, Messrs RG & A Pearce and £1,109.25, Simmental, Messrs J & A Moon.

Steers peaked at 184ppk for a quality, light weight red Limousin from Messrs HWC & JM Butler, who sold a shapely, stronger steer at 180.5ppk. Another over 180ppk was a light weight Limousin from Messrs MJ & C Plowright at 181.5ppk. Many best steers 170ppk plus. Better types 160ppk to 165ppk. Good steers 155ppk plus. Straighter sided types mid 140's.

Steers sold to £1,243.44 for a grand Limousin from Mr BA Richards, who also sold a tremendous Charolais at £1,207.31 and others at £1,178.68 and £1,172.19. Another over £1200 was a smart Limousin from Messrs JS & M Frost at £1,201.09.

One of the best shows of overage clean seen rose to 161.5ppk for a smart Limousin steer from Mr WJ Bown. Heifers peaked at 158.5ppk for a Limousin from Messrs HWC & JM Butler.

Overage heifers sold to £1,132.22, when steers sold to £1,118.72 for Charolais from Messrs RG & A Pearce.

A superb trade throughout with all abattoirs very keen to source supply. Our grateful thanks to all vendors for their efforts in presenting such a good standard of cattle. A prime example of which was an exceptionally well fed run of Friesian steers from Mr WG Down, which sold at 148ppk, 147.5ppk, 146.5ppk twice, 144ppk and 143ppk.

TB Restricted Farms

Please note if your farm is unfortunately restricted with TB and you are unable to bring your stock to our regular markets, please note we can help with finished cattle, barren cows, store cattle, dairy cattle and stirks to secure buyers.

Sale of prime cattle and barren cows can either be arranged direct off farm or via a collection in the market on a deadweight basis. Dairy cattle, store cattle and stirks may be sold by private treaty on farm. If at any time sufficient numbers and type of stock, ie dairy cattle or 2 year old store cattle become available, the market is now licensed to hold dedicated sales of TB restricted stock, when stock will be sold by auction.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.
