The trade is as dear as your auctioneer has ever seen it. All abattoirs competed fiercely to secure supply. There was a real bite to the trade. Now is the time to select barreners for sale. Sucklers rose to 149.5ppk for a Blue cross show cow from Messrs SJ & JB Clatworthy, who also sold a quality red Limousin at 140ppk. Better sucklers 130ppk plus. Good coloured cows 120ppk plus. All sucklers averaged 119.1ppk. Sucklers sold to £1,049.92 for a Blue from Messrs TH & PM Bolt. Other sucklers over £1000 at £1,041.90, Saler, Messrs AE Jefferies & Son; £1,039.03 and £1,026. Blue and Limousin from Messrs SJ & JB Clatworthy.

Black and whites exceptional. Cows peaked at 128ppk from Messrs Cole Farming Ltd. Other best cows over 120ppk from Messrs BJ & RH Bryer, 126ppk; Messrs Habberfield Bros, 126ppk, 122ppk, 121.5ppk and 120.5ppk; Messrs FE Hill & Son, 124.5ppk; Mr AAJ Bown, 124ppk; Mr PD Gooding, 124ppk; Messrs DC Dennis & Son, 122.5ppk; Messrs BJ & RH Bryer, 120ppk; Messrs PB & LM Doble, 120ppk. Good meat cows 115ppk, meat cows 110ppk, plain cows 100ppk plus. Very plain cows 90ppk plus and only absolute boners below. Young black and whites also over 120ppk at 122.5ppk thrice from Messrs FE Hill & Son, Messrs K Milverton & Son and Messrs JM & TI Rich. Others 122ppk and 121ppk from Messrs K Milverton & Son again. Black and white cows sold to £952.80 from Messrs PB & LM Doble. Others over £900 to £939.51, Messrs DC Dennis & Son; £939.40, Messrs K Milverton & Son; £938.68, Mr PD Gooding; £919.80 Messrs BJ & RH Bryer and £904.96 Messrs Cole Farming Ltd. Many, many cows £800 plus.

A well fleshed Hereford bull, with good shape from Messrs PW Baker & Son topped the day at £1,125.75 (950kg at 118.5ppk). Overage clean to 126ppk for a black and white heifer from Messrs MJ Frampton & Sons.

Livestock Pennage Security Policy

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale. If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
