Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a tight Bank Holiday entry, which met a solid trade, crowned quality consignments from Messrs J & DJ Cotterill and Messrs KR & HE Harvey. Steers sold to 159ppk for a shapely, lean Limousin from Messrs J & DJ Cotterill, who sold another at 154.5ppk. Heifers topped the day at 159.5ppk for an exceptional shaped, lean Blonde from Messrs KR & HE Harvey, who sold another at 158ppk. Better cattle generally mid forties but in short supply. Several straight sided short of 140. This week's R4L equivalent slightly affected by a high proportion of heavy steers. R4Ls generally 140ppk plus. Steers sold to £1066.13 for a quality Blonde from Messrs KR & HE Harvey, who also topped the heifers with a Blonde at £988.90. Other strong 700kg plus steers at £1062.62 (Limousin) Mr R Morrish; £1052.64, £1026.29 and £996.45, all being Blues and from Mr HC Derryman. Other strong 600kg plus heifers at £897.75 (Charolais) Messrs L & F Maddock & Son; £897.01 (Limousin) Messrs CE & BD Bailey, £894.61 (Limousin) Messrs CWH & HP Northmore and £886.87 (Simmental) Messrs JW Triggol & Son. Young Holstien bulls to 107.5ppk and £671.88 from Mr R Webber. Overage clean keenly sought to £924.30 for a Blue steer from Messrs W & KJ Hill, who sold a Limousin steer at £899.84. Overage heifers at £858.52, £836.64, £834.75 and £816, all being Limousins and from Messrs F & L Nursaw. More cattle could have

been sold to advantage when liveweight held its ground. Fortune favours the brave. Be brave, sell live.

The very best were however 210ppk plus to a top of 223ppk from Messrs RH & JA Heal; 217ppk from Mrs ME Sheppard; 213ppk and 210ppk from Messrs JR & RH Williams; 213ppk from Mr GG Gribble; 212ppk from Messrs NH Hasell & Son and 211ppk from Mr DH Sayer, Mr NW Payne, Messrs RM & BJ Norman and Messrs CW Ashford & Son. The best quality heavier lambs were £85 plus to a top of £91.50 from Mr NW Payne; £88.50 (x2) and £85.50 from Messrs MB & KN Crabb, £88.50 from Mr RC Pike, £87 from Messrs RH & JA Heal and Mr IA Wotton and £86.50 from Mr RL Kent. Overall average £77.72. A smaller entry of Hogs sold to 172 and 164ppk (£77.50 and £70.50/head) from Messrs MB & KN Crabb to average £67.97.
