A sizeable entry for the holiday weekend, which included the monthly sale of Organic stores and the Annual Honiton YFC show and sale. Trade generally firmer as graziers begin to arrive. Strong, forward cattle as dear as ever, yet not so many on offer. Grazing bullocks sold to a sharper trade. If anything, smaller, softer black and whites easier. Top of the day was £1150 for a tremendous 23m Blue steer from Katie Hopkins, Offwell. Others also part of the Honiton Show and Sale at £1080, Blue Steer (23m) Katie Maynard; £1050, Blue steer (22m), Linda Pidsley; £1020, Blue steers (23m), Danny Reed; £995, Blue Steer (22m), Jack Bartlett and £985, Blue steer (22m) Danny Reed. The third weekly consignment of Blue steers from Messrs R & E Baker & Son, Cannington, peaked at £910, (21m x7), with other bundles at £902 (x3) and £900.

The organic sale saw Angus steers (25m) to £975 from Messrs MMR & MC Mowat, Brompton Ralph. Other organic Angus (24/26m) to £765 from Mr WHG Warmington, Cothelstone. Organic Devon heifers to £640 (23/26m) from Mr I Batchelor, Cullompton. Within the commercial cattle, a good run of Limousins from (Mr K March), Barnstaple sold to £958. Other Limousins to £875 from Mr BC Knapp, Pilning. A well fleshed run of Simmentals from Messrs J & R Stanbury sold well at £950, £915 and £875. £895 was bid for a grazing Charollais (24m) from Messrs GE & EJ Nicholls, West Antsey. The best of a run of strong grazers rose to £888 from Mr FH Terrise, Okehampton. Others £870 (15/17m) Mr Rag Davey, Cullompton. Three smart Blonde grazing steers (21/22m) from Mr RM Ashman, Redhill, achieved £875. Other native steers sold to £842 for a South Devon (24m) from Messrs D Wyatt & Son, Axminster. A run of strong Freisian steers from Mr P Porter, Somerton, sold well at £788, £780, £775 and £762.

A smart, shapely 17m Limousin heifer from Mr RAG Davey topped the heifers at £900. Other Limousin to £870, also Mr BC Knapp. Well fleshed Charolais heifers sold to £855 and £790 from Messrs DJ & AM Morris, Colyton. Other Charolais at £780, also from Mr FH Terrise. Messrs DJ & AM Morris scored again with Simmental heifers at £840. Native heifers sold to £785 for Angus from Messrs CG & C Vigar, Curry Rivel. Herefords peaked at £740 from Messrs RS Spiller & Son, Honiton, who also sold a South Devon at £690. Well covered Friesian heifers at £622 from Messrs WJ Venn & Sons, Taunton. A shortage of younger stores saw 14/16m smart Limousin steers rise to £832 from Messrs ME & ML Bendle, Clayhidon, with quality 13m pure Limousin heifers from Mr WJ Bown, Catcott, at £670. Another 13m Limousin steer from Messrs JCR, MJ & DAR Stone, Nailsborne achieved £765. 12/13m Limousin steers at £735 from Mr RWM Westlake of Churchinford. Quality, well bred, white Charolais (11m) from Messrs M & A Stratton, Honiton achieved £810.
