Greenslade Taylor Hunt report another short entry of Barren stock and excellent demand throughout. Barreners are likely to be in short supply over the immediate foreseeable future and Vendors are strongly recommended to sell now. The best entry of sucklers for many weeks topped at 132.5ppk for a shapely black Limousin from Messrs AW Maidment & Partners. Another from the same farm at 116ppk. Other best coloured cows to 125ppk for a Blonde from Messrs O & K Cook; 123.5ppk for another Blonde from Messrs NM & CL Norris and 119.5ppk for a Blue from Mr C Grant-Ives. Many good meat cows 110 to 115ppk. The best of a good run from Mr PJ Betty achieved 117ppk. Very plain feeding cows around 100ppk. Sucklers sold to £1044.10 for the smart Limousin from Messrs AW Maidment & Partners. The grand 800kg Blue from Mr C Grant-Ives achieved £956. Other best cows £800 plus. Black and whites rose to 107ppk from Messrs CD & VJ Winn. A young cow from Messrs CR House & Sons achieved 105ppk. Another best cow from Messrs RS & KJ Page Bros sold well at 104.5ppk. Better cows generally 95 to 100ppk. Good meat cows 90ppk plus. Steakers 80 to 90ppk. Only very plain cows below 80ppk. Black and whites sold to £791.52 for an MRI from Messrs G & S Bryant Ltd. Others well over £700 at £784.06, Messrs HJ Bult & Son; £780, Messrs IJ & SA Bell & Son; £779.09, Messrs R & J Jones & Son and £750.75, Messrs JM & SN Faun. As with the cows, bulls also in demand to £1027.84 for a Limousin from Messrs DH & C Bennett and £1020.60 for a Simmental from Messrs M & K Churchill & Son. Many more barreners could have been sold to advantage and we strongly advise and encourage Vendors to take advantage of the current most favourable conditions.

To prevent the escape of livestock from the pennage area, please ensure:-

Outer loading bay gates are securely chained to vehicle tailboard gates when unloading or loading stock. **It will be deemed negligence if this is not done.**

Second set of loading bay gates to be secured with chain (cattle) and sliding fastener (sheep) after unloading.

Gates are always to be left in closed position when vacating loading bays.

In the event of an escape raise alarm and ensure entrance and exit gates are closed. Once entrance and exit gates are closed, then proceed to recapture stock.

Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

All cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 require two tags.

Somerset Trading Standards require any such cattle presented at market with less than two tags to be returned home under licence. Please ensure all cattle born on or after 15th April 1998 have a tag in each ear before leaving home. If a tag is lost in transit, please present tag to STS Animal Health representative for onward licence and sale.

If you are unable to replace a missing tag due to ill health or health and safety issues and would like to use market facilities, please write to Somerset Trading Standards Service, Animal Health and Welfare, Chelston, Wellington, Somerset, TA21 9HP, fax : 01823 664199 or email: ahw@somerset.gov.uk to request permission.
