Auctioneers Comments:

Greenslade Taylor Hunt report a slightly increased entry at 227 finished cattle met an improved trade, 5ppk up on average for steers. A good show of cattle generally, which topped at 179.5ppk for a top drawer, lean, red Limousin from Messrs JE & M Mather & Son, who sold a similar steer at 176.5ppk. A good run of young Limousin cross cattle from Messrs J Burrough & Co achieved 178.5ppk for a heifer, with another heifer and a steer both at 168.5ppk from the same farm. Best cattle 170ppk plus, when lean, shapely heifers from Messrs TV & E Wotton rose to 178.5ppk for a Limousin and 170ppk for a Charolais. Others 174.5ppk, Charolais heifer, Mr JPT Scott; 173.5ppk Limousin heifer, Messrs PA Strawbridge; 173ppk, Limousin steer, Messrs ARE & KA Sparks; 172ppk, barley Blue steer, Mr SER Hunt; 171ppk, Limousin heifer, Messrs MJ Tuckett & Partners and 170.5ppk three times for a Limousin steer from Messrs J & DJ Cotterill, a Limousin steer from Messrs G Vauden & Sons and a Limousin heifer from Messrs S Bye & Son. Better cattle generally 160ppk to 165ppk. Good types mid 150's and straighter sided types around 150ppk.

Steers sold to £1,259.72 for a strong Blonde from Messrs Stuart Ford & Co. Others over £1200 from Messrs DJ & CM Mitchem at £1,239.83, Charolais, £1,223.60 Limousin and £1,216.80 Charolais and from Messrs G Vauden & Sons at £1,208.57, Limousin. Many steers high £1100's.

Heifers sold to £1,093.43 for a smart Limousin from Messrs TV & E Wotton, who also sold a Charolais at £1,062.50. Others over £1000 at £1,073.44, Blue from Mr TL Greenshields & Son; £1,041.08, Charolais from Messrs Vigar Bros; £1,020.65, Limousin from Messrs J Burrough & Co and £1,010.75, Limousin from Messrs RJ, HA & MR Popham.

OTM heifers also over £1000 at £1,038.94 for a Charolais from Messrs ARE & KA Sparks. Overage steers sold to £1,081.58 for an Angus from Mr JM Cload & Partners.

Overage sold to 159.5ppk for a quality Limousin steer from Messrs JE & M Mather. Heifers rose to 153.5ppk for a Limousin from Messrs JWE & MJ Terrett.
