For Saturday 14th May 2011:- 60 day PMT date: 15th March 2011 (count day after injection as 1 and day of sale as 60).

A larger than expected entry of 1088 store cattle, stirks and sucklers, when 704 store cattle met an improved trade. The welcome rain encouraged buyers on the smaller types. Top was £1155 for a grand Charolais (overage) from Mr KLH Sweet, Highbridge.

A good run from Messrs BJ & CA Ellis, Musbury rose to £1145 for a 24m farm assured (FA) Limousin. Blue steers, 23m, from the same farm achieved £1000. Other strong Charolais steers at £1138 from Messrs RM Sparks & Son, Wellington. A run of strong continental steers from Mr D Wright, Huntworth, sold well at £1125 for a red 24m Charolais; £1120 for 24m Simmentals, £1100 for 23/24m Blues, £1095 for another 24m Charolais, £1075 24m Charolais and £1065 24m Blondes. Other Limousins rose to £1085 for a 21m steer from Mr SJ Rogers, Clevedon. Another strong run, this time from Messrs TE & J Middleton & Son, Ashreigney peaked at £1080 for a 24m (FA) Blue, with others at £1065 (22/25m) Limousins, £1050 (25/26m) Simmentals and £1040 (25m) Angus. Messrs D Wyatt & Son, Axminster, scored with 23/24m Charolais at £1048 and a red 23m Limousin at £1035. Another over £1000 was a 20m black Limousin from Messrs J Richards & Son at £1015. Other native steers sold well at £895 for a quality pure Devon (26m) from Messrs Hopcraft Ltd, Churchinford, when another pure Devon (24m) this time from Messrs KW & OF Farmer, Dunkeswell, achieved £842.

Friesian steers in good demand for all classes up to £950 for strong overage steers from Mr DA Small, Langport. A proper Friesian, 19m, from Messrs CD & BH Persey met a call of £910. Others to £790 from both Messrs NCJ & VM Froom & Son, Coombe St Nicholas (overage) and Messrs BJ & CA Ellis & Son again (23/24m).

Heifers almost hit £1000 at £995 for a well fleshed 29m red Charolais from Mr KLH Sweet again, who sold another, overage, at £990. £940 was bid for a 20m Charolais from Messrs J Richards & Son again. Charolais heifers (24m) from Mr AC Dare & Partners, North Curry, also achieved £940, who sold others at £890. £900 was bid for a Blue heifer (19m) from Messrs CD & BH Persey again. Messrs BJ & CA Ellis & Son also featured with a Charolais heifer (19m) at £895 and Blue heifers (23m) at £882. £890 was also bid for a strong Brown Swiss from Mr A Neill, Evershot. Other stronger heifers over £800 came forward from Messrs RM Sparks & Son, Wellington, being a 22m Charolais at £855; Mr SJ Rogers again, a 19m Limousin at £842; Messrs SW Clapp & Son, Wiveliscombe, a 20m Limousin at £830 and Messrs NM & CL Norris, Holford, a 20m Blonde at £825. Native heifers to £760 for an overage Hereford from Mr AW Hawkins, Culmhead.

Young stores brighter after the rain to £865 for smart 13m Limousin steers from Mr M King, Ashill. A bunch of Charolais steers, including 13/14m from Messrs AP Parris & Son, Taunton sold well at £840. A smart run from Messrs Everard Partners, Dulverton, rose to £830 for a 13m Charolais steer, with others £798, £795 and £782. A good run of Gelbvieh from Messrs J & M Fear, Mark, topped at £828 for a shapely 11m steer. A 12 month Limousin steer from Mr P Fewings & Son, Trull achieved £825. Pure Limousins from Mr WJ Bown at £805 and £774 for 13m Limousin steers and £765 and £715 for 12m and 14m heifers respectively.

Our grateful thanks to all vendors for their continued support, at a time of year when numbers usually drop off, an entry over 1000 again was excellent. With finished cattle prices holding up well at historic highs, now is a good time to sell stores.
