For Saturday 4th June 2011:- 60 day PMT date: 5th April 2011 (count day after injection as 1 and day of sale as 60).

Another large entry of 798 store cattle, 50% up on the corresponding week last year, met a steadier trade as the finished beef trade passes its zenith. Cattle generally smaller, so trade to some extent reflected the quality on offer.

Top was £1115 for a grand 27m Blue steer from Mr JM Tratt, Honiton, who sold another £1020 (25m). A bunch of strong feeding Charolais steers (24/27m) from Messrs AP Parris & Son, Taunton sold well at £1090. Other smart Charolais feeders from Messrs AC Dare & Partners, North Curry, rose to £980 (24/27m). The best of a well fleshed run of cattle from Messrs WJ & RA Alford, Craddock rose to £1065 for a 21m Limousin steer, when another shapely type, 19m, sold at £1035. Other good Limousin steers at £990 from both Mr MR Lee, West Buckland, 22m red and Messrs RS & CM Webber, Wheddon Cross, overage. Simmental steers peaked at £1050 for a quality, pure bred 22m steer from Messrs J Cockburn & Partners, Wadeford. Others to £960 (24m) from Messrs HK & S Cligg, Musbury.

Native steers, part of the monthly Angus and Hereford sale rose to £930 for both Angus steers (20m) and a Hereford steer (21m) from Messrs A Bragg & E Jennings, South Molton. Others to £890 for a 23m Hereford steer from Mr MV Hone, Beaminster and £885 for a 16m Angus steer from Mr N Trims, Weymouth.

Black and white steers in good demand for stronger types to £855 for a well grown 16m steer from Messrs A Male & Son, Kingsbury Episcopi. Others to £755 (20/27m) and £752 (18/21m) from Messrs ES Triggol, Chedzoy.

Generally more flesh on offer amongst the heifers, which topped at £1000 for a Blonde (overage) from Messrs LC Hutchings, Middlezoy. A quality pure Simmental from Messrs J Cockburn & Partners again achieved £990. Other Simmental heifers to £920 (27/28m) from Messrs HK & S Cligg, who sold another at £880 (24m). A smart Blue heifer from Messrs J Cornish & Sons, Holcombe Rogus, achieved £900, when an exceptionally shapely Blue heifer (27m) from Messrs D & M Wootton, Bovey Tracey achieved £885, who sold another, 15m at £820. Limousin heifers sold to £885 (25m) from Messrs WJ & RA Alford again, with others (20/21m) at £810 from Mr MR Lee again and £805 (21/22m) from Mr JP Tolley, Chard. Charolais heifers sold to £860 (29m) from Messrs ML & KA Ousley, Tatworth. Others to £840 (overage) from Messrs RE Fewings & Son, Littleton.

Young stores to £945 for a very well grown 15m Simmental from Messrs G Dart & Son, Molland. 14m Blue steers from Mr SJ Sibley, Beaminster, sold well at £848. A show potential 10m Blue steer from Messrs WD & AM Jamison, Lifton met fierce competition to £840. A 13m ginger Charolais steer from Messrs A Male & Son again achieved £805. Shapely, black 9m Limousin steers from Messrs A & P Bradford, Bridgwater rose to £792. Young heifers sold to £765 for a 14m Blue from Messrs D & M Wootton again.
