A new record entry of 454 stirks and busk calves, when every pen, loading bay and space was full. Entries forward from as far afield as Carmarthenshire, Bodmin, Par, Truro and Bedminster.

Another tremendous trade, when the sale ring was packed with many buyers, of whom 53 secured stock to take home to Wales, Gloucester, Essex, Norfolk and throughout the South West.

Top of the sale was £672 for a 7m 'E' Blue cross steer from Messrs EJ & JD Cope. Superb heifers from the same farm £650 (7m Blue), £645 (9m Blue), £590 (6m Blue) and £502 (7m Blue). More from John and Jenny again next week. A very shapely Charolais steer (yearling) from Mr AJ Peters achieved £658.

An excellent run of Limousin steers from the next door farm of Mrs M Forward sold particularly well at £655 (7/8m) twice, £648 (7m) thrice and £630 (8m) twice. Well grown yearling Charolais from Messrs LA & EA Heard realised £630. A quality 7m Charolais from Mrs N Hoskin rose to £618, with a 7m Blonde from the same farm at £610. Others over £600 were the best of a very smart run from Mr RS Dorse at £615 (6m) Blonde, with another 5m at £605. Better continental steers generally £550 plus. Native steers topped at £588 for smart 6/7m Herefords from Mr AM Catley-Day. £580 was bid for a 6m South Devon from Messrs JA & UJ Hopkins, who sold another, 8m, at £560. Yearling Herefords from Mr R Lovell achieved £565 and £555. After John & Jenny's Blue heifers, reported above, others rose to £560 for a yearling Charolais from Messrs LA & EA Heard again. Another yearling, Blonde from Messrs B & V Fowler achieved £545. £545 was also bid for a pedigree yearling Charolais from Mr J Wylde. Other continental heifers at and over £500 came forward from Mrs IJ Williams, 8m Blonde; Mr B Hoyles, yearling Charolais at £500 and Mr JJ Kendall, yearling Charolais at £500. Native heifers to £488 and £485 for yearling Shorthorns from Messrs S & J Willis. Many thanks to vendors and buyers alike, particularly with reference to the computer problems.
