#### **Auctioneers Comments:**

A larger entry of under thirty month prime cattle, more in line with usual numbers, met another improved trade, when the 170ppk barrier was broken for the first time for some while.

Top of the day was 174.5ppk for a stylish, well fleshed, shapely Limousin heifer from Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son, who sold other top drawer heifers at 170.5ppk and 165ppk. Better heifers generally over 150ppk at 153.5ppk and 150ppk, Limousin and South Devon, both from Messrs RJ & AM Pedrick; 153.5ppk and 150ppk both Limousins from Messrs V Young & Sons; 150.5ppk, Limousin, Mr JF Walker; 150ppk, Limousin, Mr PR Burrow and 150ppk, Limousin, Messrs FG Payne & Sons.

Better steers also over 150ppk. No absolute best types as of last week to hit last week's highs, yet a quality red Limousin from Mr J Baker peaked at 157.5ppk. Messrs V Young & Sons also scored with red Limousin steers at 156.5ppk and 152ppk. Others at 155.5ppk, Limousin Mr JF Walker again; 152ppk, Gelbvieh, Messrs J & S Vinnicombe & Son again and 150.5ppk, British Blue, Mr MC Bailey.

Good heifers and steers generally around 147ppk and 145ppk respectively. Straighter sided types around 138ppk for heifers and steers.

Overage prime sold to 141ppk for a well fleshed Limousin heifer from Mr JF Walker, who sold another similar at 138.5ppk.

Steers sold to £1066.21 for a lean Piemontese, 743kg from Messrs JH & DJ Jewell. Several other steers over £1000, with notable steers being a Hereford at £1024.43 from Messrs AAB Rowe & Son and £1004.97 for a Angus from Mr D Luff. Best heifers over £900 to £1042.97 for a strong 693kg Limousin from Mr JF Walker. Another over £1000 at £1007.48 was a Charolais from Messrs Vigar & Son.

Overage steers to £959.44 for a British Blue from Messrs Bailey Bros and £898.38 for a Charolais heifer from Messrs RG & A Pearce.

We now enter the count down to this year's Christmas Show on 6<sup>th</sup> December, the South West Winter Fair, which has attracted entries of haltered cattle from as far afield as North Wales, Lincoln and Cornwall. Over forty trade stands are booked. A very full show and a busy day awaits. We ask as many readers as possible to come and support the show. We are delighted to welcome so many exhibitors to Sedgemoor but nothing delights exhibitor's more than a large crowd watching them show their stock.

The show is dependant on the income from trade stands. Trade stand holders will only continue to support the show if those attending the show take the time to peruse their stands.

This year's show is the last big show of the year and is going to be a grand finale. The winter showing season is bubbling to a climax with Smithfield having taken place, The National being held this weekend, the Royal Welsh thereafter all leading to our South West Winter Fair. All are welcome and entry is free. Please come and support the show, create a buzz and atmosphere to make this year's show a day to remember.
